What a wonderful Sunday morning 12th July? I've been round the cattle and they are all OK. I'm now at the marsh enjoying a splendid view over the Wash. It's about half a moon, so a neap tide, that will be in around midday. It won't come anywhere near the saltmarsh and may well stand for nearly an hour before turning and starting to flow back. My dogs have had a good run and are now resting beside me in my truck.

I have been watching a ship come into the Wash and it has now turned north-west and come through Freeman's Channel, before turning south-west again and heading for the Witham Haven. Soon the pilot cutter will come racing out and put the pilot on, with the ship still moving, so that he can use his knowledge and skill to avoid the sand bars etc. whilst steering the vessel up the river and into the dock at Boston.

A blue sky with a few white clouds, warm sun and a lovely clear view. The wind turbines at Gedney are motionless. The marsh has rafts of purple sea lavender which is at its best now. There are plenty of teasels on the sea bank and, at close inspection, I see bumble bees and scores of ladybirds on their mauve flowers.

We have been plagued with aphids, green, black and mealy and the ladybirds and hover flies are a Godsend to us organic farmers. We are very pleased to see them and hope they have a great banquet!

I have picked a small bunch of lavender to put in a vase, it doesn't need any water and will keep its colour for many weeks.

To sit here is sheer delight, but why am I the only one?

Come on Wrangle, get up and enjoy it. You don't know what you are missing!!!

Uncertain Times

It seems that, at present, advice about how to stay safe keeps changing. It is interesting that the COVID-19 virus itself has not changed but it is our understanding of its nature and behaviour that keeps changing.

At the heart of the issue is to be more concerned with our neighbour than ourselves and to try and do nothing that may harm our neighbour - whoever our neighbour may be - in any situation at home, at work, in the shops or on a visit to the doctors or hospital etc.

In the Church, here in the Coastal Cluster of Parishes, we are having to adapt to change. Change the way we pray and worship to be safe and to continue to do as scripture asks, which is to love and care for one another. Church involves intimacy, sharing and close friendships yet to stay safe we are to care "from a distance" and not share or greet physically. This feels strange and has meant that we have not had the opportunity say farewell to Rev'd Fiona Cotton-Betteridge in the way we would have liked, but we wish her well in her ministry to the people of the Barrow-on-Soar Area in Leicestershire. Marc Cooper and Myself have to adapt to ministering without Fiona. We will try and work out who will become your vicar, but in the meantime as Rural Dean that responsibility falls on me.

As 21st century Christians our understanding of ourselves and of the universe has changed but God our heavenly Father, who created it all, has not. God is the "Same Yesterday, Today and Forever". It is not that the human endeavour of discovery has made God irrelevant - rather it has made clearer the Majesty of God. "The heavens declare the Glory of God" (Psalm 19). As with the COVID virus our understanding of nature of God has had to change and grow as our understanding of God's creation has grown and changed. Our understanding of God has to mature and we need to take responsibility for our failure to tend the earth in a way that life flourishes, to be more humble before God and one another. More than ever we need to seek the common good and work together with concern for one another. Interestingly the war generation know this, but we have to discover it afresh in each generation. The leaders of our times are having to change to ensure fairness, justice and the dignity of every life is valued and observed by all. Every life matters. Change can only come when the hearts of men and women are transformed by love and the God who is love.

So in these uncertain times do not fear, for God is with us and let us love and care for one another for love comes from God.

Take care, stay safe and God bless you.




BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

There is a fee of £5 per entry, payable to Wrangle PCC






