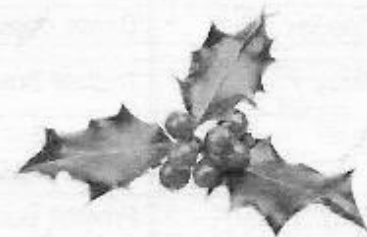

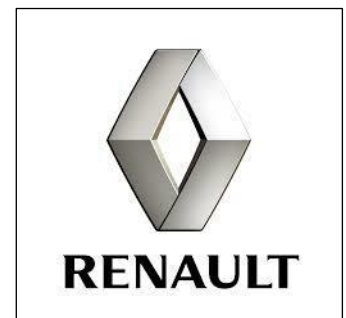

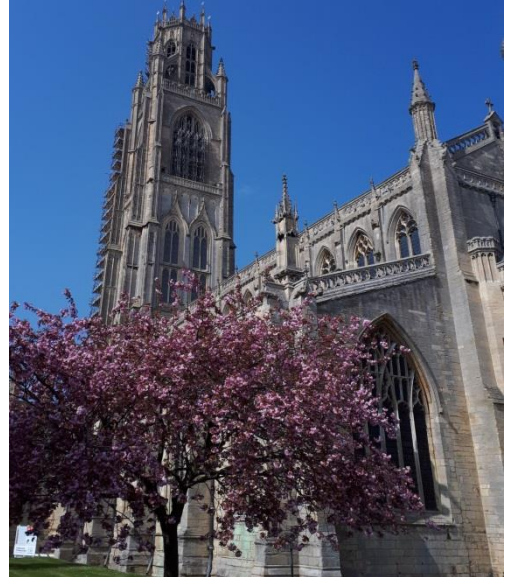

Fly Tipping (Section 33 Environmental Protection Act 1990)

Boston Borough Council has the responsibility for collecting fly-tipped waste and, wherever possible, locate and **prosecute** the offenders.

The service costs the tax payer a great deal of money in time and man power. Hundreds of fly tipped items are collected every year, these range from domestic black bags, tyres, mattresses, televisions, white goods furniture and many more items that are picked up from across the borough.

Householders, with waste to dispose of, need to check that any contractors they use have a **waste carriers' licence** before allowing them to take away any rubbish. If you fail to do this and the rubbish is disposed of illegally, the householder is liable, not the contractor, and could face a £400 fine.

Many of these items can be disposed of and recycled **FREE OF CHARGE** at the LCC household waste recycling centres. Bookings have to be made by phone or online at the present time.

Fly tipping is the unauthorised deposit of household waste on land which has no license to accept waste, such as on the public highway, grass verges and car parks. Fly-tipping is a criminal offence and you can be fined or prosecuted, with maximum penalty on conviction of £50,000 and/or imprisonment for those convicted of the offence.

We also issue fixed penalty notices (FPN's) between £200 – £400 for smaller fly-tipping offences. These fixed penalty notices are an addition to existing powers of prosecution and provide additional means of enforcement for less serious offences for fly tipping. Some FPN's can be appealed, if this is the case it will tell you on the FPN how and who to appeal to.

How much are fines for fly tipping?

- Car Boot Load – £200
- Small van load – £250
 - Trailer Load – £300
 - Transit Load – £350
 - Tipper Load – £400

How is the money received from FPN's used?

A contractor carries out enforcement action, they do not charge for this service, instead they retain any payments received which means the money is used for carrying out environmental crime enforcement. If the Borough Council issue any FPN's this money received is spent on education or enforcement around environmental crime.

Anyone finding fly tipped waste should contact the Borough Council by calling **01205 314200** or completing the [Fly Tipping Report it Form](#) on the **myboston.gov.uk** website. Please make a note of as many details as you can for example the location including postcode, description of items fly tipped, date, time and whether or not you witnessed the offence. Boston Borough Council aim to remove the waste within 3 working days

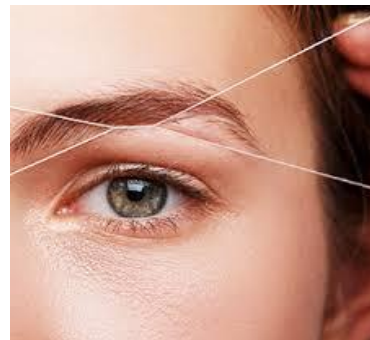

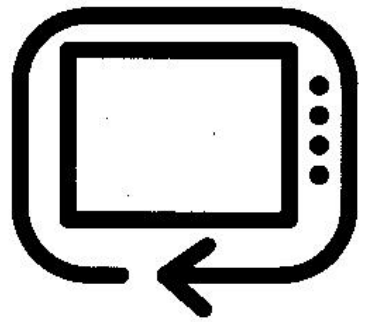
