#### **Declarations of Interest**

Cllrs Bowles and Edwards declared an interest, by email, in planning application B/20/0304.

#### Approve minutes of the remote meeting held on 07 July 2020

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes, and will be signed by the Chairman in due course.

#### Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

There was no report from the PCSO.

Borough Cllr Ashton reported by email:

The alliance with ELDC is continuing to develop well. Committee business has resumed with Boston becoming the first Licensing Authority to revoke an alcohol licence for premises in breach of Covid restrictions. County Cllr Skinner reported:

Highways Officers have met with the residents at Main Road regarding the vibration from the traffic on the A52. Works will be carried out in March 2021 to try and alleviate the situation. The request for an advisory speed limit of 40mph has been sent to Highways.

#### **Recreation Field**

Following discussion it was resolved that the play area be unlocked, the trees will be checked beforehand since a branch fell off one on a windy day. Signs will be put up stating that the play area is to be used at 'your own risk' with instructions regarding the use of user's own hand sanitiser etc. Branches have fall off some trees in the area of the outdoor gym and one in the play area. The trees will be looked at before the play area is re-opened.


