

Notes of the remote Parish Council meeting held on 06 October 2020 attended

Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve minutes of the remote meeting held on 06 October 2020

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes, and will be signed by the Chairman in due course.

Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

The PCSO reported by email:

1 theft at Bull Drove; 2 incidents of anti-social behaviour at Wrangle Bank and at Church Close; 1 incident of criminal damage at Main Road; 2 incidents of violence at Bull Drove; 2 transport hazards at Main Road; 2 road traffic collisions at Main Road; 1 burglary at Main Road and 1 concern for safety at Main Road

County Cllr Skinner reported:

The Borough Council are currently preparing for lockdown. The Boston Town Deal, with funding of £25m, plus an additional £13m, has been sent to the Government for approval. This will be a big investment in the town. When the Port of Boston was in use the town was successful, so there are plans to expand the port again to be used for exporting food. Following two visits with Highways Officers the grates in the A52 have been levelled and the flooding problem at Chapel Lane is being discussed with Anglian Water to try and resolve the problem. The pothole across Sea Lane has been repaired, but the road is still in an atrocious condition. A 'Find and Fix' team has been in the area and reported various 'issues' for repair, the reporting will be more specific in the future. The County Council has received funding for food banks to feed Children. A question was asked about the parking in Boston that will be affected by the Boston Town Deal. A variety of projects for the town were consulted on and discussed before the final project was submitted.

Borough Cllr Ashton reported:

The Local Government Association are working on a Draft Code of Conduct, when the Code of Conduct has been adopted by Boston Borough Council this will also become the new Parish Council Code of Conduct.

Draft budget to set the precept for 2021/2022

The draft budget, with details of reserves, and the budget control to date with anticipated spending was sent to all Councillors prior to the meeting. Some amendments were suggested ready for confirmation at the December meeting. It is anticipated that the precept will be £22,000 for 2021/2022

Recreation Field

The current Government guidelines for play areas is that they should remain open. A leak on the tank in the pavilion has been repaired. No further issues with moles have been reported.

Glass can be mixed in the glass banks when the required one is full. Fly-tipping should be reported to the Borough Council on 01205 314200

Highways

The Gride in Old Leake is in a poor state of repair. County Cllr Skinner reported that finance for the repairs has now been agreed. The interactive speed sign is not in use at present.


