Now that's more like it! After several weeks of cold north and east winds summer has at last arrived. This is a particularly lovely time of the year, the trees and hedges are adorned with fresh, green leaves and we have had an excellent show of May blossom. Wild roses are just coming out, and the evening sun has the countryside bathed in a wonderful glow with long shadows.

I was pleased to see a cuckoo, at the Sailor's Home, on the 10th June but, though I watched it for 20 minutes, it wouldn't oblige me by calling. Fortunately, I did hear it, or another one, the following day but have not heard it since.

We have 6 young dabchicks (little grebes) on the clay pit and, although still very young, they are constantly diving and re-emerging just like their parents. Yesterday, 12th June, a pair of shelducks had 12 newly hatched ducklings on the same pit. They had gone today, I expect, to start their long walk to the marsh. I have seen them in the past, the duck walking down the road with a string of ducklings following in line. Their destination is right out on the mud-flats, where a few adults look after a crèche of many youngsters. Most of the adults fly off to the German Bight where they moult and, briefly losing the ability to fly, remain in relative safety while their flight feathers renew, before returning to the UK.

We are surrounded by the wonder of nature and are so lucky to live here.

The coffee morning at the Church proved successful with around forty-five people attending. At last we were able to hold this event, with social distancing, and it seems a lot of residents were pleased to have somewhere locally to have a drink and a chat.

I see no reason to relax our caution and risk re-fuelling the pandemic by dropping our guard too soon.

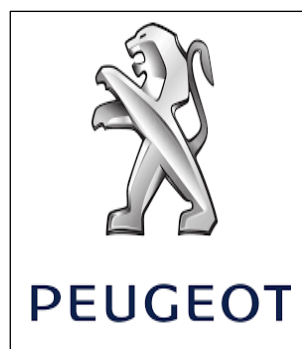

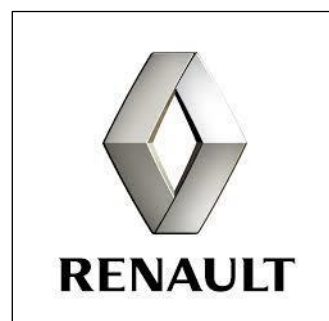

Why not make a bird feeder?



What you will need:

- Sharpened pencil
- Ice cream cone
- Pipe cleaner (chenille stem)
- Peanut butter or softened lard
- Cheerios™ cereal
- Birdseed

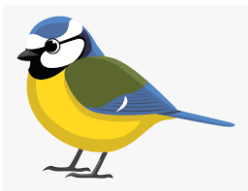
Use the pencil to carefully poke a hole in the pointed end of the ice cream cone.

Twist a knot in the end of the pipe cleaner. Thread the pipe cleaner into the ice cream cone and out of the hole (the knot will hold the pipe cleaner in place).

Spread the peanut butter, or lard, on the outside of the cone. Press the cereal all over the peanut butter to cover the cone. Sprinkle the birdseed over the cone, pressing it into the peanut butter with your fingers.

Hang in a tree for the birds to enjoy!

(Always use softened lard where someone may have an allergy to nuts)

There was no report from the PCSO

Borough Councillor Pickett reported:

The Borough Council AGM was held last week. The Boston marathon went ahead as planned at the weekend.

The County Cllr Skinner reported:

The first face to face Full Council meeting has been held. Speeding in the villages along the A52 is being looked at by LCC and LRSP, with speed reduction schemes being considered.

Re-surfacing of the roads is now taking place, a request has been put in to lift the grates so they do not get covered with tarmac and stones.

Recreation Field

The work to remove the re-growth of the trees at the rear of the Mel Marshall Way properties has been carried out. The evergreen oak tree has been straightened up. A broken branch in a tree by a neighbouring property will be removed. Some low branches in the play area are to be removed. The loose pole by the bowling green has been checked, it needs to be set lower in the ground. If this there are any unforeseen issues it will be removed. The moles will be reported to the contractor. A thank you letter will be sent to the Borough Council refuse collecting team for constantly collecting the fly-tipping at the recreation field and around the village. Discussions took place regarding the poor methods and organisation when taking waste to the recycling centre. A letter will be sent to LCC regarding this matter.

Audit for the year ended 31 March 2021

To approve the Fixed Assets: All Councillors have a copy of the Fixed Assets. Questions were asked about a seat in the village, it was resolved that it is not owned by the Parish Council. The list of assets was approved and signed by the Chairman.

To complete the Annual Governance Statement: The Chairman read out each of the statements in the Annual Governance Statement and ticked the relevant box on response received from Councillors. The form was signed as required.

To approve the Accounting Statement: The Clerk read out the figures in the Accounting Statement. The figures were approved by the Council and the form was signed as required.

Street lighting

The Parish Council pay Boston Borough Council for the lighting on the side roads in the village. A breakdown of the costs for electricity, number of lights repaired and if the energy is renewable has been requested. Lincolnshire County Council provide the lighting at Main Road.

Local issues regarding water pressure in the village

There have been issues with the water pressure in the village, particularly in the Main Road, Mill Lane and Broadgate area where residents report that they do not have enough water to have a shower or to use their washing machines. Following discussion it was resolved to write to Anglian Water regarding this poor situation

Plans received

Cllr Ashton left the meeting while the next item was discussed.

The Parish Council have **NO OBJECTIONS** to the following planning application only if the infrastructure listed is put in place first:

B/21/0145 - Mr J H Ashton - Construction of 9 dwellings at Land off Broadgate, Wrangle

Infrastructure required: Increased water pressure for the area, the Parish Council have written to Anglian Water regarding this existing issue; improved sewerage system, again the Parish Council have written to Anglian Water regarding this existing problem with the sewerage system in this area of the village due to the system currently running at capacity; assurances that the surface water will not be running over the road and flooding the properties opposite due to the land being higher than that opposite; no buildings. Trees or high hedges should not be put in the front gardens as this site is on a very sharp bend and sight lines are needed for the numerous, and variety of, vehicles that use this road – a passing place on the bend should be a consideration and a footway.

Cllr Ashton returned to the meeting

A letter of thanks has been sent to the Borough Council Cleansing Team just to say thank you for continually collecting the fly-tipped waste from the Recreation Field and from other areas in the village. It is not a job they should have to do ever, but it has been made a worse job due to the pandemic and risk of getting Covid 19 with not knowing what they are collecting. They have also continued to empty the household waste and the litter bins around the village, only pausing when Covid did get to them.

Thanks should also go to the local residents who pick up litter on their trips in various areas of the village, and also in the recreation field. Again, the litter should not be there, but thank you to those who collect it when they see it – please be careful when you are doing this good deed though.

The interactive speed sign should be back in place now and the data collected from the sign will start to appear in this Parish News again.

The Parish Council Audit paperwork is now available in the village notice boards and on the Parish website. The notice boards are at the recreation field and outside the Parish Hall, by the bus stop.

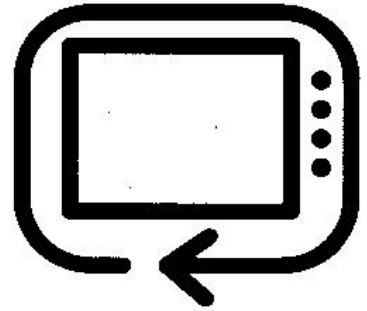
