It's almost mid-September and the recent new moon tides had left the marsh salty, but yesterday's sharp shower has freshened it up. This morning our 30 cattle are spread over a large area, grazing happily. The tide has almost two hours to run but a small cargo vessel, having just taken on the pilot, is already making steady progress on its long journey up the Witham Haven into Boston.

Harvest is all but completed, after an interrupted start, and autumn cultivations will soon be underway.

Church services have resumed, on two or three Sundays per month, and we are now allowed to sing again. Sadly, congregations are small and we are always pleased to welcome new people in to join us. We have a beautiful church, well maintained, as too is the large churchyard and our thanks to the sterling work of our volunteers.

The swallows are now gathering into large groups, ready for the long migration to South Africa. I estimated close on 200 birds on the telephone wires towards the Sailor's Home this week.

My vantage point, on the outer sea bank, is the ideal place to write my editorial – quiet, calm, a beautiful scene and absolute peace. Why can't all the world be like this, and everyone get on well with their neighbour?

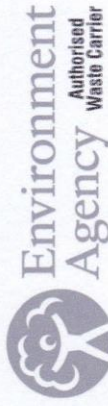

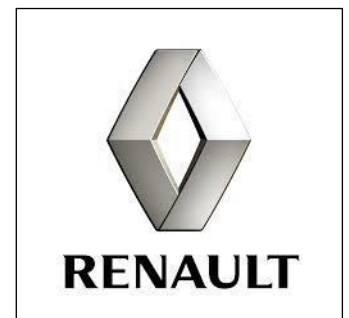

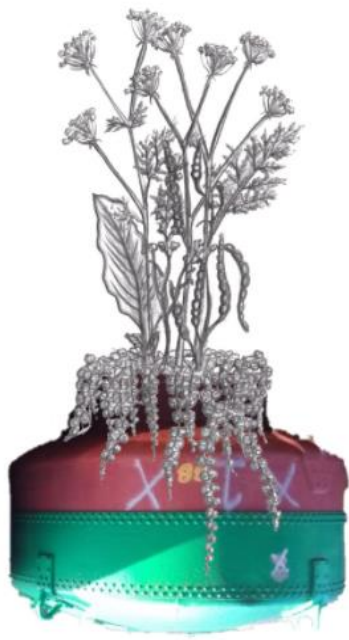

Boston Bouys



The Boston Bouys trail is a series of six stunning art installations re-purposing vintage navigational marine buoys. The artworks celebrate Boston's rich heritage and maritime connections, capturing our fascination with exploration across the world.

Three artists, Jo Chapman, Carrie Reichardt and Bex Simon have worked on two buoys each, designing the sculptures with cradles of steel seaweed, mosaic mermaids, and forged metal flowers, respectively.

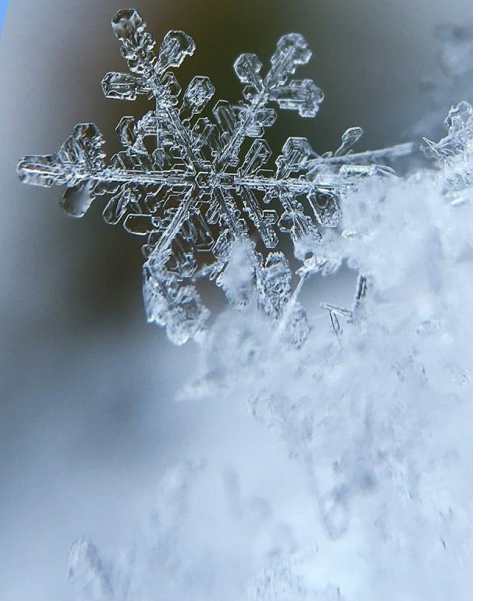
At a glance: COVID-19 Autumn and Winter Plan

Vaccines - maximise uptake of those eligible but yet to take up the offer, offering booster doses to individuals who received vaccination in Phase 1 of the COVID-19 vaccination programme (priority groups 1-9) and offering a first dose of vaccine to 12-15 year olds.

Test, tracing and isolation - everyone with COVID-19 symptoms should still self-isolate and take a PCR test and the legal requirement to self-isolate if positive remains. Practical and financial support for those eligible will end March 2022.

Free flu vaccination extended to secondary school children and 50-64 year olds.

Encourage safer behaviours - fresh air, face coverings, test and isolate if required, stay at home if you are unwell, regular hand washing and download and use the NHS COVID-19 app

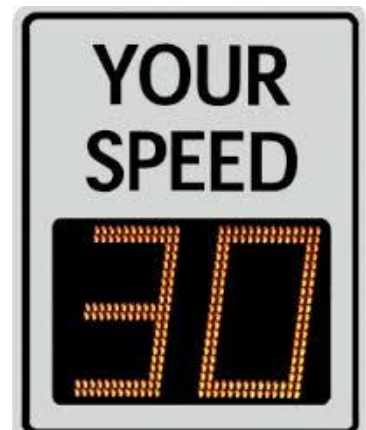

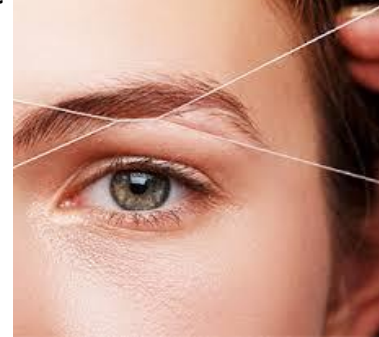

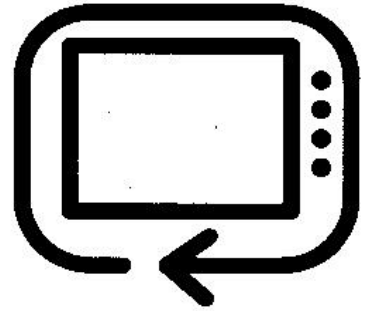
