Love Living Life

We can sometimes take life for granted and finding ourselves amidst lots of tasks. Challenges that mean we find ourselves just trying to survive, and some of us get beyond caring about wider issues until they directly affect us. Days can be endured rather than enjoyed. We have recently seen the joy of people succeeding in sport, be that in tennis, the Olympics, the Paralympics or in football - this joy has involved lots of preparation, training and hard work.

This can apply to our lives, hence the saying "we get out of life what we put in". But life is not fair, and bad things can happen to good people, so how do we enable one another to enjoy life? The pandemic seems to have made us aware that caring and looking out for one another enriches both the giver and receiver.

The key thing is to start each day giving thanks that you are alive, and to try and make most of the precious gift of life. Joy and happiness are important in life and I learnt a lot, from a lady in her 90's, about thankfulness and contentment - she started each day being thankful because she was alive and she appreciated the blessings that we have around us, but many take for granted. She had an attitude of gratitude. She struggled to walk and endured the aches and pains that an old body can bring, but her mind seemed to rise above it all with a determination that, regardless of the setbacks and challenges afflicting her, she was going to enjoy the gift of life that day.

The lady would often mention that she had so much to be thankful for, even though an outsider might think she had to struggle to do many things. But she took delight in what we have here in our villages and what we have here in Britain. I once remember her saying "You know we are so fortunate to have our British weather, no two days are the same. We're never quite sure what each day will bring, it must be so boring being in countries where the weather is the same most days."

My mind thought of places like Spain and Egypt where they can go for weeks, months, and even years, enjoying the sunshine every day, but I was then reminded that we need rain to grow food plants and all the other life around us. Rain feeds the plants, the flowers and the trees which in turn feed the animals, the birds and the bees. Our British weather means that every day is a bit of an adventure with an element of uncertainty and surprise in how things might pan out. That lady had learned to love living and to love the surprises and the challenges of life. The uncertainty seemed to be a source of interest and meant that each day drew attention to something unplanned.

God has been described as a God of surprises. Science cannot predict surprises because they are one off events. The beauty of sport is that there are so many variables and choices that the outcome is not certain. Everything has to be right on the day and we have seen the underdogs win, which gives others hope that they too can achieve what seems a difficult dream.

Learning to Love Living Life and value this precious gift brings contentment. That includes valuing others who share the gift of life on this planet and to nurture our environment, workplaces and social lives to bring growth which is healthy and so bring prosperity with time for people to enjoy life, rather than just simply endure life should be at the heart of who we are as human beings.



Twenty Years of the Boston Woods Trust



It is now two decades since the Boston Woods Trust was formed to manage the newly planted Westgate Wood, and to develop plans for more woods around Boston.

We are now excited to announce the development of a new site, located behind the houses on Willoughby Road. We have Richard Dion to thank for making it possible to create a 35-acre Nature Reserve which will have a matrix of woods, wildflower glades and meadow, plus a small lake.

The lake has now been dug and most of the paths laid but, due to various delays, the planned planting of over 16,000 trees will not take place until next year. We will then have an expended Boston Tree Party when everyone is welcome to get involved with the tree planting.

This will be our third site, and each will have a different character. The new Dion's Wood will be a Nature Reserve where dogs will not be allowed.

Many people are familiar with our first site, the Sir Joseph Banks Country Park, which incorporates Westgate, Jenny's and the Oak Woods as well as the wildflower meadows. This has long been popular with dog walkers but during the lockdowns many more families have come to appreciate this facility which is freely available on our doorstep.

The 80-acre site has about 5km of paths allowing access for all and there are numerous points of interest including the new Butterfly story telling seat, the community orchard, Owl Tower and Lincolnshire Road Victims Memorial. There is also an orienteering trail - find details on the website

The woods are open 24/7 and dogs, under control, are welcome. There is ample free parking on Old Hammond Beck Road, Five House Lane and at West End Road, where you will find Jenny's Shepherd's Hut offering refreshments.

Our second site was the Fenside Woods, the small but beautifully formed Grange Wood is the first wood on Fenside Road – look out for the snowdrops in spring. Further along Fenside Road is the 22-acre Beech Wood where you will find several wooden carvings to add interest to your walks, although the trees and birds are the main attraction.

A section of the wood is also home to our Beech Wood Green Burial site. This is developing into a tranquil final resting place for loved ones where either full burial or interment of ashes can be accommodated. It is possible to reserve a plot for future use, as a means of confirming your wishes to the family when the time comes.

When Dion's Wood is established, we will have nearly 150 acres of woods and parkland which offer recreational space for the health and well-being of visitors whilst also contributing to the fight against climate change and providing wildlife habitats to help increase biodiversity.

All this comes at a cost, and we welcome regular supporters who, for from just £20.00pa can become a part of the project. There are also a range of sponsorship opportunities, perhaps in memory of loved ones, or could you consider leaving us a legacy to continue the work in the future? Fireworks light up the night sky; soon Remembrance Day will be here. As the colours of autumn diminish, we approach the end of the year...


Shop shelves once more seek attention, with dazzling Christmas displays.
