14th January 2022, another new year and let's hope this <u>is</u> a happy one. Fingers crossed the pandemic is beginning to fade, thanks mainly to the amazing vaccine roll-out.

A bright, crisp morning with a good rime frost. I took my collie Jess for a stroll round the grass fields and margins. She soon came across a dead stoat, freshly killed I expect by our black cat. It's a long time since I saw one but, no doubt, there's plenty of wildlife sees us that we don't know about. A buzzard flew across the Spinney field, and there were several fieldfares on the top of the thorn bushes. A nice flock of linnets flew into the treetops.

Six roe deer stood out alongside a reedy dyke, and a dozen curlews glided down to feed on the grassland. I made my way along the permissive path where it runs beside a long hedgerow. We had planted several oak trees next to the hedge and some had grown out towards the light. We need to side prune and tie them back so that they grow up straight.

We started back via the brickpits where I stopped to take a couple of photos for the magazine cover. I had seen two hares and a pheasant, and a woodcock burst out noisily from the hedge bottom. Almost back at the yard I noticed the land drains were running well. This field was gripped by hand by a wonderful craftsman, George Forth, and I lead the clay pipes out for him when I was eighteen years old. 56 years and as good as the day he put them in.

Like most things Church events have been very quiet, or non-existent, for the past two years. This has resulted in very low income whilst running costs have continued. We are fortunate to benefit from the income from the magazine adverts, and thanks go to our advertisers for their continued support. I remember the magazine from the early 1950's but, no doubt, it goes back further than that. It was then solely produced by the Church.

Several years ago it was suggested that Parish Council should produce a free magazine for the community. Following negotiations with the Church it was agreed that the two organisations would produce a free magazine, and that the Church would continue to deliver copies as before, as well as setting out and printing, whilst the Council would cover the expenses. The Church receives the income from the adverts.

Past Present Future

Happy New year.

It has been interesting that in December and January the uncertainty, relating to the latest strain of the pandemic, meant that people' adjusted their plans, sometimes at short notice.



My own family made several adjustments in the week before Christmas based on test results but actually this resulted in an intimate and relaxed first Christmas week.

It was interesting to see how the four nations of the UK responded differently based on their different experiences of the past, the different assessments of what was presently happening in their location, and the different actions needed to assure a vibrant future.

We here in rural Lincolnshire live life very differently to those in urban settings. Something that is highly appropriate in an urban community may not even be necessary in a low-density rural community. Our experience of the past and our understanding of what is important in the present gives rise to a variety of views and hopes for the future. Someone working in a hospital ward facing the reality of a virus at close quarters and its daily impact will be different to someone who has been fortunate to stay at home well away from danger. But lack of experience can affect our judgement of what is real and important.

This works on a personal level and sharing our experiences can increase understanding and help us make better judgements in future. This is the same with faith and trust in God. If our experience of God is remote, we may consider God as irrelevant to our lives. If, however, we have experienced the work of God the Holy Spirit up close and personal then we may have encountered glimpses of glory that fill us with awe and wonder and we can see how God works with us in today's world. This informs our understanding of the importance to act with love and care for one another today and faithfully holding the promises of God for the future

At Christmas a Star was born who offers us presence in the present and hope for the future based on historical experiences and promises in the past. As we move into this new year let us hold on to the promises honoured in the past and dare to receive the work of God in our lives today with the hope and new growth ahead of us this Spring





Apologies were accepted from Cllrs Seymour, Pickett and Ashton.

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve minutes of the meeting held on 07 September 2021

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes and signed by the Chairman.

The County Councillor was not present

Recreation Field

Cllrs reported on the work carried out on the dyke in the recreation field behind Mel Marshall Way - one resident came out to give a hand, which was appreciated. The dyke has been cleared and the water can now be seen running. The dyke will now be maintained regularly to prevent it getting into a poor state again. The bridge has not been removed, this will be discussed at the next meeting if it is still in situ. One branch needs to be removed from the big tree, and the ivy needs to be cut around the tree. The elder behind the toilet block needs to be removed in due course. The moles will be dealt with if the traps do not get stolen again.


