Following a very dry start to 2022 the weather is now beginning to break up. Two named storms are on their way, with strong gales. Signs of spring are already appearing though, with lots of snowdrops, some aconites and small green buds showing on the hawthorn hedges. The first daffodils are just showing colour and will soon be in profusion.

We have just planted eight good pedunculate oak trees in a roadside grass field, to create parkland. These have been fenced round to protect from cattle and roe deer.

The cover picture shows the interactive speed sign on the main road, which has been non-operational for some time. Now that the obstacles, put there to obstruct collection and replacement for charging, have been removed normal service should be resumed. Several speeding vehicles have been observed, including many tractors travelling way beyond their legal limit of 25 mph.

I have been re-shafting some hand tools, and this has become quite a challenge now, since quality new shafts are all but impossible to source, and the correct rivets rarely available. This brings back memories of our excellent old blacksmith, Mr. Spikings, an absolute master craftsman, who was so pleased to show anyone with obvious interest how the job should be done. He said that he learned, as an apprentice to Mr. Parker (I believe of Sibsey) who would say that the shaft should look as though it had 'grown in the socket'. I need a couple of double bend spade shafts, but can't find any and there are no proper hand-fork shafts to be found anywhere.



WITHAM FOURTH DISTRICT IDB

2021 turned out to be a "normal" year in that we did not have an extreme weather event and the rain fell evenly across the year. We took **637mm** of rain (25 inches) across the District, compared to around **786mm** (31 inches) in 2019. From January to December 2021 we pumped a total of **13,040** hours in our manned and unmanned pumping stations, this equates to approximately **131 million tonnes of water**. (Rutland Water holds 124 million tonnes!)


This meant that we were able to concentrate on our maintenance programme and we put together a number of bids for capital projects funded by the Environment Agency. We received £160,000 to improve and expand our telemetry system which provides remote data on actual rainfall and water levels around the system. We then use this data to automatically turn on electric pumps to manage water levels. We were also successful in attracting £360,000 of funding to replace weed screen cleaners and control panels at our Lade Bank and Hobhole Pumping Stations that will be delivered in early 2022. This will help with the significant weed build up in front of our Pumping Stations, when we are pumping.

Next year we are looking at replacing Wrangle Pumping station at Friskney which will cost around £2.5M and will be funded by the Environment Agency. More details will be provided next year.

Finally, COVID permitting, we are hoping to hold another Heritage Open Day at Lade Bank in September and details will appear in the Boston Standard.




