Loving Neighbours as Ourselves.

With Spring giving signs of new life and hope, and with the relaxing of COVID restrictions the world has now been plunged into another crisis in Ukraine.

The people of Ukraine have been trying to get on with an unreasonable neighbour. They had tried to do all their neighbour had asked of them to keep peace. They had not joined the European Union or NATO just as



to keep peace. They had not joined the European Union or NATO just as their neighbour had asked. Yet they now find their people, including children, the sick and the elderly, being indiscriminately murdered and their homes destroyed forcing people to flee their homes to safety as a reward for trying to live in peace with their neighbour.

We appear to have been financing such deeds through choosing to purchase cheaper fossil fuels rather than making ourselves self-sufficient on the energy sources available in our own water rich land with wind and sun. We perhaps need to be wiser in our use of money and whilst we may suffer in the short term with the price of energy, we still have far more than the Ukrainian people no longer have. We can be thankful in counting our blessings

At the end of Romans 12 vs 21 says 21 Do not be overcome by evil but overcome evil with good". We have seen so much good in the response of ordinary people both here and in the nations surrounding the Ukraine being generous with help, hospitality and love that is both inspiring and immediate. In the face of evil we find hope. They have the compassion mindset of acting in the same way we ourselves would like to be treated in the same circumstances. The encouragement "To love our neighbours as ourselves "

Jesus also encouraged people to love and yet those in power had him killed in a most public and brutal way even though no criminal charge could be substantiated. In the face evil Jesus faced evil head on with compassion and love with the knowledge that those who bring the evils of suffering and death will perish. In just three days Jesus demonstrated that those unjust and evil deeds were overcome.

God word's to Joshua were "to be strong and of good courage, obey God and do not fear for God is with you wherever you go". I am reminded of Moses bringing God's message to Pharoah to Let God's people. Whilst Pharoah stubbornly tried to out-wit God, in the end, and after much unnecessary suffering of his people, Pharoah is unable to stand against the mighty acts of God. Maybe we need to show the same faith and trust in God today as God's people did then.

Let us join in powerful prayer for the people of the Ukraine and pray for a mighty miracle to overcome the current evils with something good. And may we discern how we can be people of faith hope, love and action in our troubled world.

At Easter Christ overcame injustice and death and brought new life. May we all put our faith in him and overcome the evil we face with good. May we bless others by loving our neighbours (near and far) as ourselves and may God deliver us from evil. and bless the powerful acts of love
