What an excellent spring we are having, and how glorious the bright greens of the new leaves on the trees and hedges? A multitude of flowers now coming into bloom. Dandelions in profusion and the similar looking coltsfoot, the one that shows its flowers before the leaves appear. This was commonly known as clay leaf because it favours heavy soils.

Butterflies are appearing, especially the beautiful yellow brimstone, I have seen several recently. The warm, sunny days have also brought out peacocks and small white.

Curlews fly in every morning to feed on the grassland, and I love to hear their calls. A song thrush is singing daily at the brick pits. These are very scarce now, and we never see the scatter of brown and yellow snail shells around an old brick or bottle. We have a resident snipe on the wetland and I hope it is breeding. Shelducks have started visiting the wetland pools and, no doubt, are looking round for rabbit holes to nest in. I am seeing muntjacs and roe deer daily, the latter often just giving their position away by their tall, V-shaped ears showing above the grass margins.

From a farming perspective this is the easiest spring sowing and planting time we have had for years. The only thing lacking from times gone bye was a good frost mould, when cultivations were easily done with a set of harrows and a small tractor. Now tractors and equipment are getting ever bigger and, whilst forcing an acceptable tilth, are consuming endless gallons of ever more costly fuel. And they think this is progress!

WRANGLE PARISH HALL ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

During the AGM in March 2020 both the secretary and booking clerk positions could not be filled, so the meeting was adjourned to orgainsie an EGM. The EGM could not be held due to COVID restrictions. Resigning committee members agreed, over the phone, to continue for the unforseeable future and help through the pandemic.

The hall was closed until 20 September, but had to be monitored for insurance purposes, briefly opening agin under COVID guidelines for two months. The hall was again closed between 20 November and 21 April. During April, hirers started to use the hall again with all COVID restrictions being adherred to.

During these diffucult times the hall was fortunate to secure Government COVID funding. Meetings were held, less frequently, via Zoom.

Tony reported that he could no longer cut the grass, but Mick Ross helped with this up to the end of October, for this the committee would like to say 'Thank You'.

During last year the hall had to play 'catch-up' with maintenance including the heating, the lighting, the fire alarm and the PAT testing.

We would like to thank Terry Woods for clearing the over-hang on the footpath, free of charge.

Our long-standing treasurer, Tony Wright, sadly resigned in October due to family commitments. A heart-felt thank you for your accountancy, grass-cutting and loyalty over the years, it has been very much appreciated. As Tony had been the British Legion representative, Clare Law was asked to join the committee. It was agreed that I would become acting treasurer.

In November the committee was asked, by Mrs Sarah Bailey, if she could host a Christmas Fayre and erect a Christmas tree in the hall grounds. The event was to be held in December and include a light switch-on. This was agreed and the event was very well attended and successful.

Weekly bookings are good, but ther is still room for more – please support your Parish Hall if you can.



Mel Marshall Way is named because:

Melanie Jayne Marshall MBE was born in Boston and brought up in Wrangle, attending Wrangle Primary School and learning to swim in the school pool.

She is a former British swimmer who has won numerous medals for her country, as well as being a swimming coach of the year for her work with Adam Peaty in Derby and later in Loughborough.

Her international career started at the 1995 European Youth Olympics in Bath, where she won four gold medals.

Melanie was ranked number one in the world in 2004 after breaking the British 200m freestyle record to ensure selection to the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens.

Melanie has won two silver medals and a bronze medal at World Championships as part of the British freestyle relay team.

In European Championships she has won one team gold and silver together with one individual gold, a silver and a bronze.

Melanie has seven Commonwealth medals, six of which were gained in Melbourne in 2006. Her Commonwealth medals include four silvers as part of a team and one individual, the others being two individual bronze medals.

Following her retirement in 2008, Melanie became the head coach at City of Derby Swimming Club, where she first began coaching Commonwealth, European, World and Olympic champion Adam Peaty.

In 2014 she was international swim coach of the year.

Melanie was appointed Member of the Order of the British Empire (MBE) in the 2021 Birthday Honours for services to swimming and charity.



Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve minutes of the meeting held on 01 March 2022

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes and signed by the Chairman.

Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

County Cllr Skinner reported Staff are beginning to come back to the Borough council offices to work and are all working towards getting members of the public back into the building. Works are proposed at the Geoff Moulder swimming pool and gym to bring it up to date and improve the facilities for all users. The Government will not give LCC £12m requested for highways. This money was found from reserves for last year, but now the reserves are spent. The result is that the highways services will be worse than it has previously been. Lincolnshire has missed out on the 'leveling up' funds in the first round, but it is hoped that there will be some funding from the next round.

Recreation Field

Work has been carried out in the car park to level it up, the entrance by the road will be looked at to see if anything can be done to prevent it from moving again. Anglian Water have cleared the area they own. The stumps on the side of the dyke need to be removed. Cllrs will have a look at the ivy growing around the trees in the field with a view to cutting a section out to stop it growing up the trees.
