Just past the middle of May and still not many swallows or house martins about. They are really late this time and numbers are very low. At my yard I have just one solitary swallow waiting for a mate. Although cuckoos are reported around the county I have still to hear one. We usually have a lot of reed warblers nesting in our dykes with old reeds, I heard the first males singing last week. There's a pair of lovely yellow wagtails on our marsh grassland. The male is a really vivid yellow – a beautiful, delicate bird that doesn't hop like most small birds, but runs rapidly to catch insects over the grass. They often hunt among the cattle's legs as they disturb the flies.

I am pleased I've seen more brown hares recently, though some don't like them because they eat a few vegetable plants. How can that matter when full crops of mature vegetables are being chopped and ploughed in unharvested?

It will be time for the Platinum Jubilee celebrations by the time this production is out, and planning is well underway for another memorable event. Volunteers are needed to help prepare food on the Sunday morning, if you would like to join in.

Then, only four weeks later, it will be the Wrangle Show returning after a two year break, due to covid. I hope we will have a good day, and a good crowd to reward all the hard work of the organising volunteers. As ever Wrangle does things well – please support us.

At the Church services are being held three times a month but, like all churches, congregations are reducing, thus income is decreasing while running costs are rising. The church is for all the village, not just regular attenders, and if we want the church to be there for weddings, christenings and funerals etc. for future generations, it is incumbent on us all to help keep it functioning. 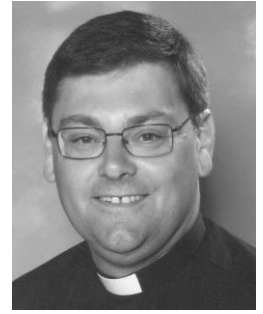

This month we celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, a mark of her steadfast sacrificial service to the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth. ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON 03 MAY 2022

There were six members of the public present.

The minutes of the meeting, held remotely on 06 April 2021 were approved and signed.

The Chairman of the Parish Council gave his annual report:

An unusual year to say the least – largely due to the covid pandemic. We had remote meetings in April and May, followed by three meetings in the Chapel school room, then back to base at the Parish Hall in October.

In May our member, Cllr Frank Picket, was elected Mayor of Boston – our congratulations were expressed at the time.

The Wrangle Show Committee, wanting to do something for the village, decided to provide a village sign. The Parish Council agreed to contribute towards the cost (via s137) and, hopefully the sign will be erected before long.

We have provided a defibrillator for the Youth Club and agreed to provide another for the school building which will be accessible to all.

Lincolnshire police sent us incident reports until September, and then announced there would be no more.

The trees in the Community Orchard are thriving but fruit production has been disappointing.

Moles and dog fouling continue to be a problem at the recreation field despite our efforts to deal with this.

New building in the village has been limited, despite substantial areas with outline planning.

As usual a wreath was laid at the war memorial on Remembrance Sunday.

The interactive speed sign, although out of action for some time, gives a fairly static picture of the traffic flows and speeds through the village.

The Boston marathon, well supported, only briefly included our roads this time.

There have been a number of issues with street-lights, the Borough Council expecting us to fund replacements and removals.

The Parish News production continues and is well received. My thanks to everyone involved.

We have once again supported village organisations with S137 payments.

Volunteers are making plans for the Platinum Jubilee celebrations in June 2022.

The weekly Rural Bus Service, a lifeline for non-drivers in the outlying areas is, sadly faltering. We hope sufficient backing can be secured to keep it running.

The Parish Council has continued to fund footpath maintenance. The Borough Council is now in an alliance with East Lindsey and South Holland forming the South-East Lincolnshire Partnership. Unfortunately this doesn't look like improving our seriously deteriorating road infrastructure.

As ever our clerk, Teddy, has done a first-class job in keeping up with all the changes and rules, and especially with the website and production of the magazine, thank you.

Finally, my thanks to my vice chairman, Bryan, and all our members for your continued work and support. May I wish the council all the best for the ensuing year.

The accounts for the year ended 31 December 2021 both for the Wrangle Consolidated Charities and the Alenson & Erskine Foundation were outlined.

There was no correspondence received for this meeting, however a member of the public did raise the issue that there seems to be rumours around the village regarding Wrangle Chapel, it was resolved that the Clerk contact the Minister and ask if there is any information about the future of the Chapel and it's use as a building.

There was no other business to discuss, the meeting was closed.

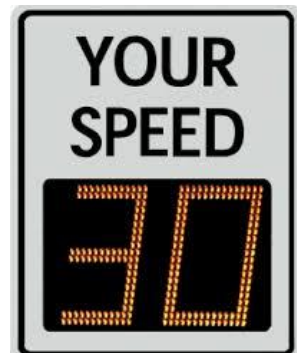

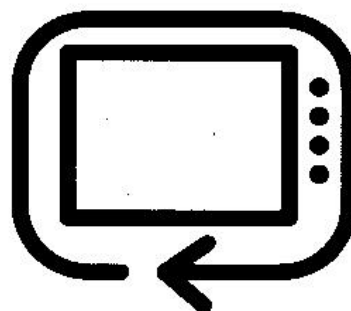
