Generally farms have achieved the quickest and easiest harvest for many years. The prolonged hot, dry weather has ripened cereals and pulses earlier and virtually removed the need for any artificial drying. Straw is the downside, having been made so brittle, and has smashed up in the combines. Bedding the cattle yards will be more laborious.

Recent rains have transformed our lawns and pastures from being brown, shrivelled and tired into lush, green and fast growing in just a few days.

Wildlife has enjoyed a good season and, to my amazement, I was able to count 32 yellow wagtails on Old Leake Sea Lane a few weeks ago. I have never seen a family of more than 8 to 10 together before. Two pairs of dabchicks have bred successfully on our clay pit. My first wheatear of the autumn appeared on the sea bank on 13th September and an early skein of pinkfeet geese flew over, high, the following day.

Our new village sign, designed and funded jointly by the Wrangle Show committee and the Parish Council will be erected, at Church End, well before this magazine is out. There will also be a lovely Platinum Jubilee bench installed at the same location. A pleasant place to sit and watch the world go by.

How sad it is that we learned that our wonderful Queen Elizabeth II had died aged 96, at Balmoral, and so soon after those memorable celebrations.

Her Majesty has served Britain and the Commonwealth so well during her record breaking 70 years and is renowned throughout the world, for her dignity, her wisdom, her warmth and cheerful sense of humour.

May she rest in Eternal Peace. We now celebrate the accession of our new Monarch, King Charles III.



Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve minutes of the meeting held on 07 June 2022

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes and signed by the Chairman.

Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

Borough Cllr Pickett reported that the Borough Council has obtained some large grants to help with projects to improve Boston. Improvement works at the Geoff Moulder Leisure Centre will be carried out.

Recreation Field

The bridge across the dyke has been partly removed, the Parish Council will arrange for it to be completely removed. Wrangle FC have not paid the pitch fees for 2021/22 season, the reason being that the moles have caused the home matches to be played away. As this was not brought to the attention of the Parish Council until the invoice was sent out, the fees should be paid. The hedge behind the fence at the play area will be 'laid' later in the year. The rotten wood covering windows and doors at the pavilion need to be replaced, the handyman will be asked to do this work. Tarmac will be purchased to fill the holes in at the entrance to the car park.

Glass can be mixed in the glass banks when the required one is full.
