We've been blessed with a welcome, long dry spell of weather which has enabled us to get most of the late vegetable land ploughed. These fields had been abused by the heavy harvesting rigs.

The pools on the wetlands have, at last, gained some water that is attracting some interesting wildfowl. Grey lag and Canada geese, as well as numerous ducks including shovelers, wigeon, teal, mallards, shelducks and gadwalls appear most days. Waders include good flocks of curlews, a couple of snipe and a green sandpiper.

Two song thrushes are now singing every morning at the yard, starting before daylight and woodpigeons are already practicing their summer cooing.

Whilst the weather has been kind to us, we must spare a thought for all those poor folk affected by the terrible earthquakes in Turkey and North Syria. Once again those real extremes occurred many miles away, but the situation is very grave for millions of people left homeless in bitterly cold conditions.

The nights are pulling out now and there's a feel of spring in the air. The grass is still growing and, unless we get one of those periods of cold east winds, turnout for the cattle could be early this year.

The water table is well down so we need some significant rain or another very dry growing period will be a problem again after planting.




