A dry start to the year has allowed us to sow six fields of barley in wonderful conditions. It has been many years since we have experienced such a good frost mould. The land was ploughed early, before that spell of really penetrating frosts in December.

Daffodils are in full bloom and, as ever, the strong winds have arrived to give them a good shake up.

We have had our share of road closures and diversions in the village lately. Some improvements have been made but so many roads, especially the old fen banks: Gold Fen bank, Wrangle Bank and Lade Bank in Wrangle, and Fodder Dyke Bank, Bell Water Bank and Thorpe Bank in neighbouring parishes, are cracking and collapsing towards the drains. I can't see the Highway Authority ever affording to put all these in order and, if they could, it would only be temporary – they would soon fail again.

All of these banks were constructed to push the fresh, fen water back – starting with the A52 – the Rampar (local name for rampart, or bank).

The 'toft' land to the south-east of the A52 was dry and inhabited, because the sea banks were constructed to hold the salt water back. The first sea banks were soon followed by reclamations in 1810 and 1960 following the accretion of silt from the five rivers that flow into the Wash and deposit silt on our foreshore.
