After the long, dry spell the frequent rains are now becoming quite a challenge. It is getting late to drill spring cereals and they used to say "cuckoo barley" is no good. Let's hope this familiar spring arrival holds off for a bit. I saw my first clutch of young birds on 11th April – 7 coot chicks on the clay pit, the parents diving down to bring up weed to pass to the small black puff-balls with red caps.

Our marsh harriers have just returned from warmer climes, after breeding successfully last summer. They are more streamlined and agile than the resident buzzards. The lovely yellow brimstone butterflies, mostly the first to appear, have now been joined by a few peacocks and several bumble bees. Rook numbers seem to be increasing annually. We have many rookeries in the village now and the birds, quite wary for most of the year, are now prepared to make their nests much lower and often near to houses. With their pick axe like bills they can soon uproot a significant amount of freshly drilled corn.

Song thrushes have stopped singing and blackbirds have now started. I expect to see a swallow any time and I hope there are many more than last year. Robins and wrens continue to entertain us with their shrill clear voices.

Muntjac deer are becoming quite tame and make us aware of their presence by their sharp barking at dusk. I'm getting a few sparrows back now after several weeks without any – mostly house sparrows.

By the time this edition is out it will soon be local council elections, quickly followed by King Charles III Coronation. This will be a truly spectacular ceremony and something most of the population will not have witnessed before.





Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve minutes of the meeting held on 07 March 2022

The notes, previously circulated, were approved as the minutes and signed by the Chairman.

Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

Borough Cllrs Ashton and Pickett had nothing to report due to being in the pre-election period. County Cllr Skinner reported that a lot of repairs have been carried out. The request for a Zebra crossing will be chased up. The 30mph limit for Broadgate could take up to 18 months to put in place.

The village sign

A letter has been received from the Wrangle Show Committee 'gifting' the new village sign to the village to be kept in the care of the Parish Council, there were no objections to this. The sign, the base and the Jubilee bench will be added to the insurance policy and the Assets Register

Recreation Field

The moles have re-appeared. The dyke has been cleared, thanks were expressed to the Councillor who did this work. The pot holes at the entrance to the car park need to be filled in.

Plans received

There were no planning applications for this meeting.

Highways

The Borough Council were asked about the electricity supply for the street lights. It is in a contract until 01 October 2024 and has signed up to another contract from then until 01 October 2028. The Parish Council pay for the electricity, but have no say in the seeking of contracts. The answers to other questions were not adequate and a response is awaited from the Climate Change and Environment Officer. The pot holes in Sea Lane, towards the Sailors Home, are in need of repair, the grass verge is being used to get around them. The speed sign seems to be needing to be charged too often, this will be monitored.
