Water levels are low in our brickpits and lake, after the shortfall of winter rain, so we are using it sparingly. Like everyone else I'm hoping for rain before long. On the flip side we have made a good amount of excellent, wrapped silage recently.

I wonder if there will be a bit of this glorious weather left for our Wrangle Show on 2<sup>nd</sup> July. The committee has arranged another action-packed day for us and, I hope, we will get plenty of local support. Any help with preparations and on the day will be greatly appreciated.

I was disappointed to learn yesterday that vandals had forced entry into a changing room at the bowls club. Stores and equipment had been strewn about, leaving club members to clear up and re-secure. How much better if the rascals had channelled their energy into something useful?

#### WITHAM FOURTH DISTRICT IDB

2022 turned out to be a very dry year with hardly any rainfall from April 2022. We pumped for 8,271 hours (2021 - 13,040hrs) and average rainfall to December 2022 was only 421mm (2021 - 535mm). Over time, an average year would see around 578mm of rainfall.

For a second year, this meant that we were able to concentrate on our maintenance programme and repairing the numerous slips that occur (there is another one on the Fodderdike Drain that will shortly be repaired). We continue to work hard on a number of funding bids for capital projects and over the next 15 years, there is an ambitious Capital Replacement Programme totalling £55M that will be almost entirely funded by DEFRA.

In 2023 we will begin working on a new pumping station at Wrangle that will replace the existing station built in the 1940's at a cost of £4M. Replacement weed screen cleaners and control panels at our Lade Bank Pumping Station have been completed in 2022 that will help with the significant weed build up we get in front of our Pumping Stations, when were are pumping.

This continued investment will ensure that we are able to maintain the standard of protection for the district.





#### Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

An email received from the Borough Councillors was read out. They have been attending training, reporting pot holes on Fix my Street and looking to get events in the Parish Hall and asking residents to consider volunteering.

County Cllr Skinner reported that some potholes had been filled in; a drain cover had been stolen and replaced so residents should be careful when parking; the Zebra Crossing request has been submitted to LCC and if there are any issue with public footpaths they should be reported to Cllr Skinner.

#### **Recreation Field**

Mini motor bikes have been used on the recreation field, this is not allowed. It was resolved to ask the Borough Council for a copy of the by-laws for the Borough. The play area inspection has been ordered. An email has been received from a resident with regard to fencing falling towards the dyke in the recreation field. It was resolved that the Parish Council can do nothing about this as the fence is the responsibility of the resident as is the dyke by the fence, being a half-dyke.

Concerns were expressed regarding the radiation from this monopole being sited so close to the Primary School. It was resolved to ask if a Risk Assessment had been carried out and if Environmental Health had, or would be, consulted regarding this matter.

#### **Highways**

The telegraph poles on the bend in Broadgate by Broadgate House are leaning towards the road, this will be reported to LCC. The WRANGLE nameplate at Main Road has been hit and has spun round, this will be reported to the Borough Council. The road surface at Church Lane is narrowing due to the high banks around the field and mud being swept towards the 'banks' and staying on the road surface, hence making it narrower. This will be reported to LCC.


