Congratulations to our show committee. They've done it again! The weather was kind and we had a successful show. Ring events were very popular with a good mix of attractions. Several new volunteer helpers responded to advert requests and the workload was spread more widely than usual, easing the pressure on the small committee. This was good to see and we had a real community event which bodes well for the future.

Very well done Wrangle and thanks to all concerned.

Once again we have experienced a long, dry spell but, as I write, the rain is now coming down and, if it lasts, prospects are looking better for the veg. crops.

There are two clutches of tufted ducklings on the clay pit. These are diving ducks and the young are already popping up and down making it difficult to count how many. The marsh is quiet and peaceful and the lovely sea-lavender is now at its best, with rafts of mauve for a far as you can see. Avocets have bred in Wrangle this year, on the new borrow pits adjacent to the sea bank.

On 13th July I hosted a visit by 37 children and some staff from Wrangle Primary school. A perfect day and a really enthusiastic group, learning about flowers, and wildlife and especially the profusion of small frogs and toads. I issued the children with quiz sheets to complete on their return to school. Very well behaved and an enjoyable experience.




