12. PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

Comments are to be sent regarding the following planning application:

B/23/0198	Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind	Statutory Pre-Application and Scoping Consultation to Boston Borough Council under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 and the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 prior to the submission of an application for Phase 2 of the Outer Dowsing Offshore Wind proposals to include both offshore and onshore infrastructure for a generating station and up to 93 wind turbines at Outer Dowsing Offshore/Onshore, Lincolnshire Coast Line
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Although no route has been decided, due to costs, it is thought that there will be 7 – 8 vehicles per hour carrying stone to the site whilst work is being carried out. Therefore a one-way system for the vehicles should be considered; something in place to remove any mud on the roads left by the vehicles and repairs to the damaged caused by the heavy vehicles must be considered. One person in a position for community liaison for ease of contact with Outer Dowsing whilst work is being carried out.
