What a summer we've had? Rain on most days in July, and I recorded almost 4 inches for the month (97)mm. August began wet but then we experienced the record, very warm spell that enabled most of the harvest to be brought in, and in good condition.

Swallows were slow to arrive and in poor numbers this year but, despite this, I am now seeing very large flocks gathering ready for their return to Africa for winter. Moving some of this year's bean harvest from the drying shed disturbed myriads of what looked like pollen beetles. Quickly the swallows latched on, flying in and out of the shed and all around, clearly feasting on the flying insects. A welcome feast that should help them survive their long journey. I estimated 200 to 300 on the wires over the yard!

A few days ago a beautiful hobby, a small falcon, appeared and soon many of the swallows disappeared, except for one very brave little chap who chased and harried the hobby wherever it flew.

We have a good show of dragonflies and damsel flies on the farm currently. It has been an amazing season for blackberries and our sloes and scads are prolific. Walnuts are a bit less than usual but our many oak trees have the most acorns I have ever seen. Extremes of weather but, once again, nature provides.

Today, 13<sup>th</sup> September, I gathered some samphire from the edge of the saltmarsh. I was surprised how much samphire there was, and how much the saltmarsh has 'gone out' over recent years. I had further to walk than expected.







By providing safe places for hedgehogs to live, you're much more likely to see these prickly creatures in your garden.



Sadly the number of hedgehogs in the UK has plummeted over recent years. While there were estimated to be around 1.5 million in 1995, today there is believed to be less than 500,000.

Hedgehogs need homes just like humans, so making one for them is a great way to encourage them into your garden. Hedgehogs are becoming increasingly reliant on urban and suburban gardens. Urban populations of hedgehogs have increased by up to a third, while rural populations have halved. This decline is likely caused by the loss and degradation of our habitats due to pressures such as development, agricultural intensification and climate change.

So, whether you live in town or country, you can help to look after garden wildlife like hedgehogs by providing food, water and shelter. The cross section above give an idea of what you could do for hedgehogs..

Pick a shady, quiet spot to put your hedgehog house. Lift the lid off the house, and put the dry leaves inside.

Cover the lid with polythene sheeting (making sure it's still accessible for cleaning later on), and pack soil and dead leaves around the outside, leaving the entrance free of debris.

Clear out the hedgehog house once a year (late March to early April) to prevent the build-up of pests. Do not clean it out if a hedgehog is in residence though!

Making a <u>log pile</u> or <u>compost heap</u> are also good options for providing space for hedgehogs to nest, and have the added bonus of attracting lots of insects for them to eat!



#### WRANGLE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING NOTES

There were three members of the public present, one came along to listen to the meeting, one gave an update on the 5G pole to be sited on land opposite the Primary School at Main Road and the third was there to assist Rev. Dr Val Odgen.

7.30pm Rev. Dr Val Ogden arrived, she came along to outline the situation at the Methodist Chapel and the work done to try and keep the Chapel open. The final comments were to ask if anyone had any idea as to what the building could now be used for. As there was no thoughts forthcoming this will be on the agenda for the next meeting when Councillors have had time to consider the situation. (Any ideas can be emailed to wranglepc@aol.com)

Apologies: received from Cllrs Edwards and Featherstone, County Cllr Skinner and Borough Cllr Butler.

Also present: Borough Cllr Baxter and two members of the public

#### **Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

#### Approve minutes of the meetings held on 04 July 2023

The notes of the Annual Parish Council meeting and the Parish Council meeting, previously circulated, were both approved as the minutes and signed by the Chairman.

#### Receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

#### Borough Cllr Baxter reported:

The Outer Dowsing cables will run through Wrangle Common and Old Leake Commonside. The Geoff Moulder Leisure Centre has been taken over by Parkwood Leisure who will improve the facilities and endeavour to keep one swimming pool open at any time. The Public Protection Orders have been renewed and a Fixed Penalty Notice will be £100 for anyone caught breaking the rules regarding dog fouling and littering. These Orders cover the whole of the Boston Borough. The new Communities portfolio holder will be arranging a meeting for Clerks and Chairs to attend. Issues at China Street have been reported on Fix my Street. Street lighting issues will be discussed under Highways and any comments sent to the Clerk at Old Leake.

#### County Cllr Skinner was not present

#### **Recreation Field**

An inspection of the play area and outdoor gym equipment has been carried out, there are no issues, everything checked is 'low risk' and will be monitored. The Clerk will check if the football team are going to use the facilities this year.

#### Glass can be mixed in the glass banks when the required one is full. Fly-tipping should be reported to the Borough Council on 01205 314200

#### Dog fouling is still an issue - especially on the football pitch, the recreation field is for the use of everyone PLEASE ALWAYS PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG

#### <u>Highways</u>

An email has been received from Boston Borough Council with details from a report carried out on the street lights in Wrangle. The conclusion is that the Parish Council will have to pay around £13,500 to the Borough Council in addition to the £2800 paid for the electricity and maintenance in 2022/23. The Parish Council have also been advised of a possible 150% energy increase. The Borough Council pay nothing, other than insurance, for the street lights, it would be good practice if they paid for the lights to be changed to LED to help with Parish Council costs for electricity and maintenance. An email has been received from Old Leake Parish Council regarding the charges being suggested for the street lighting. Comments regarding the owner and insurer of the assets will be added to the list of issues already outlined by Old Leake, as will the lack of consultation of electric supplier for the street lights. The roadway to the Sea Bank needs some repair work, this is the responsibility of the Parish Council. A rough idea of the cost will be sought for the next meeting. The gullies along the A52 need checking and clearing before the bad weather starts. They are full with mud and debris. Can they be checked for running under the road too, this is to prevent any possible flooding issues for residents at Main Road? A manhole cover in the Main Road has been loose for a few months, it will be reported again for repair.


