It's Friday 13th October, after a wet night and there's water everywhere. I'm on the sea bank and the new moon tide is at the marsh edge. A marsh harrier has just passed low across in front of me. It's quite mild but autumn weather is imminent, apparently. The pinkfeet geese are here again, in very high numbers and, along with increasing numbers of whooper swans, are enjoying the residue of the maize harvest.

Although our weather patterns continue to frustrate us we must always remember how lucky we are to live in a land of food abundance, peace and comfort, whilst our TV screens are continually filled with atrocities, wars and every natural disaster we can imagine.

It's now Sunday 15th, same place and autumn has arrived! NW biting wind, bright sun and the grass covered with white frost. We'll soon need to consider bringing the cattle in. Fortunately there is still plenty of grass, and leaf on the hedges, so they have good shade and plenty to eat.

Two small boats are anchored, way out from Benington, fishing I expect and hoping to catch some early cod and whiting. About 80 whoopers are on the stubble at Leverton, and I was pleased to see three adult grey partridges at Claxey Bank yesterday. Once we saw them daily, and heard their distinctive *chi-veek* call as the coveys fed on the farmland. I remember finding a nest with 19 eggs beneath a spear thistle, on the verge towards the Sailor's Home. They really were The Good Old Days

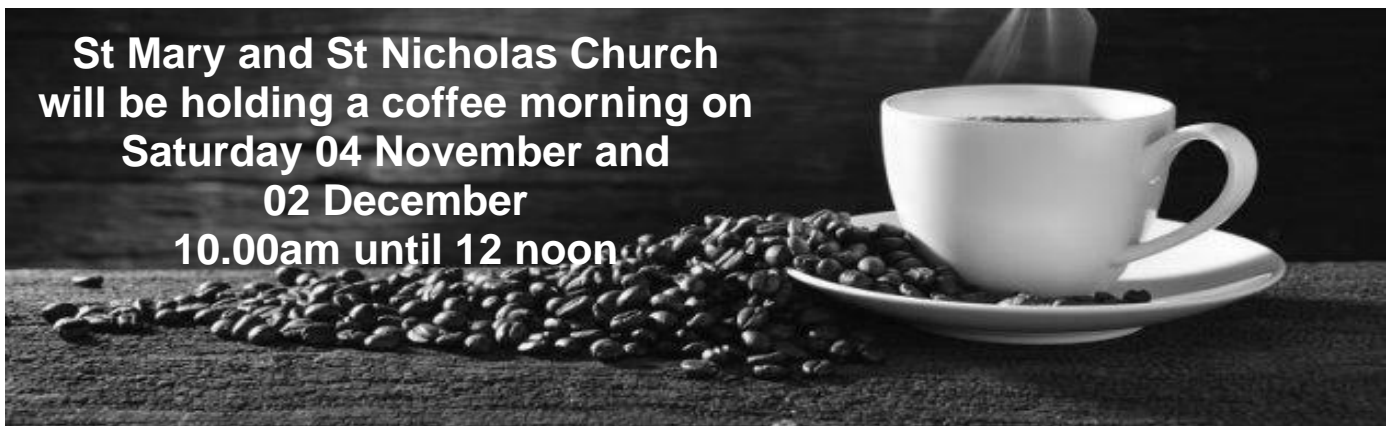

by John McCrae

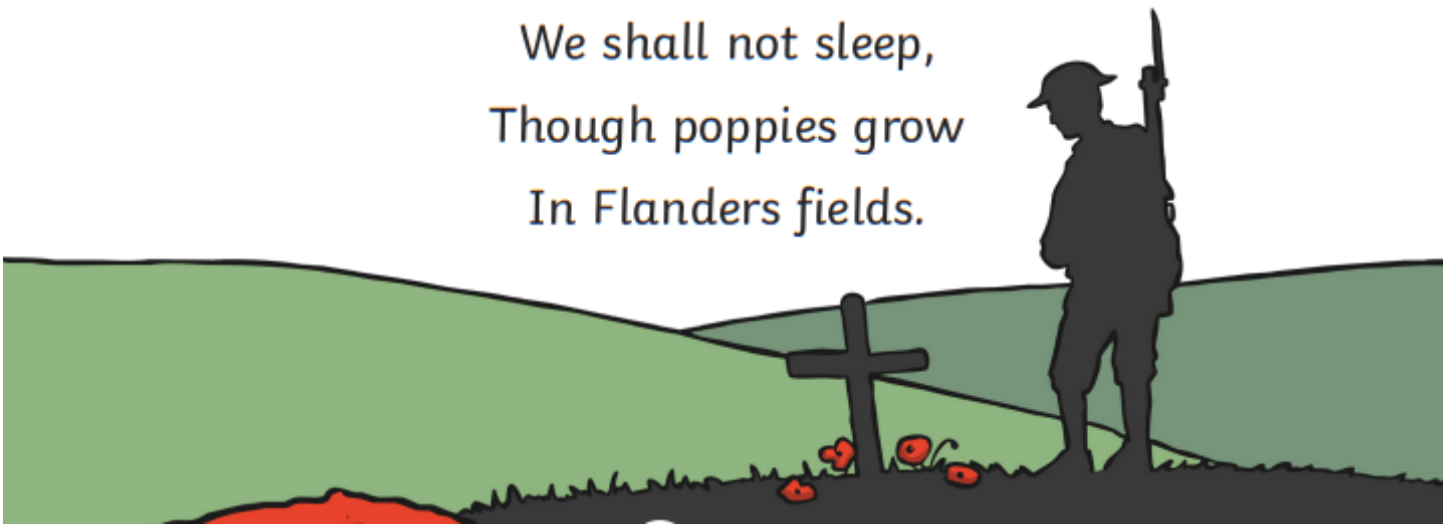
In Flanders fields the poppies blow

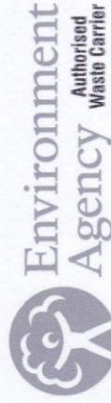

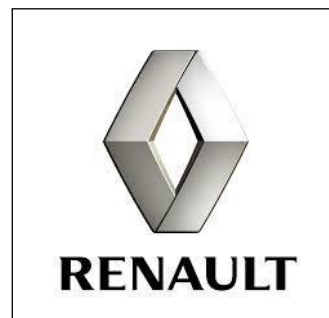

There will no longer be a dedicated PCSO who covers Wrangle. Potholes are still being reported including some on Bull Drove and China Street. The ongoing situation with street lighting is being led by Old Leake Parish Council on behalf of all Parishes in Boston. The new Public Space Protection Orders went live on 02 October - you must have the means to pick up after your dog, put your dog on a lead when requested to do so by an officer and NOT let your dog in a children's play park – the fine is £100.00.

County Cllr Skinner reported:

It does not cost much more to train a Constable than a PCSO, hence there are now more warranted officers. Some of the PCSO's are now constables. County Cllr Skinner is on the Police and Crime Commissioners Panel. An alternative site is being sought for the 5G mast.

The footway at Main Road has been repaired. Four gullies by the school have been cleared. The drain at Gowt Bank will be reported again. There is an additional £10m to add to the existing £19m available for Highways. There are 5500 miles of roadway in Lincolnshire; these have 24,000 potholes currently for repair. LCC spend £25,000 per mile on the roads compared to £62,000 being spent in London. The last verge cutting will take place before 08 October, if any has been missed please report to Cllr Skinner. Dogs running free should be reported to the Borough Council.
