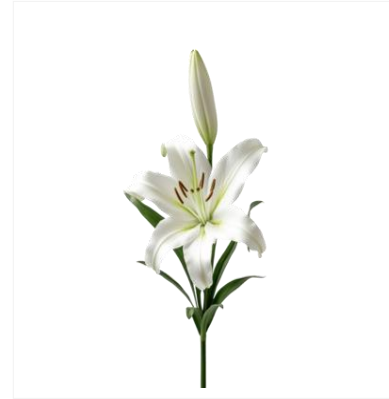

It is hoped families will make the most of these events which have been lined up for the whole community, **many of which are completely free.**

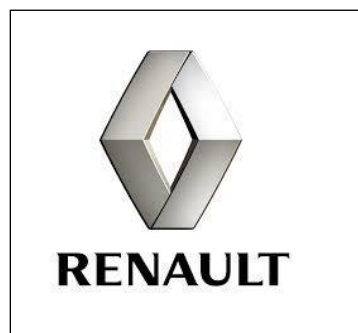

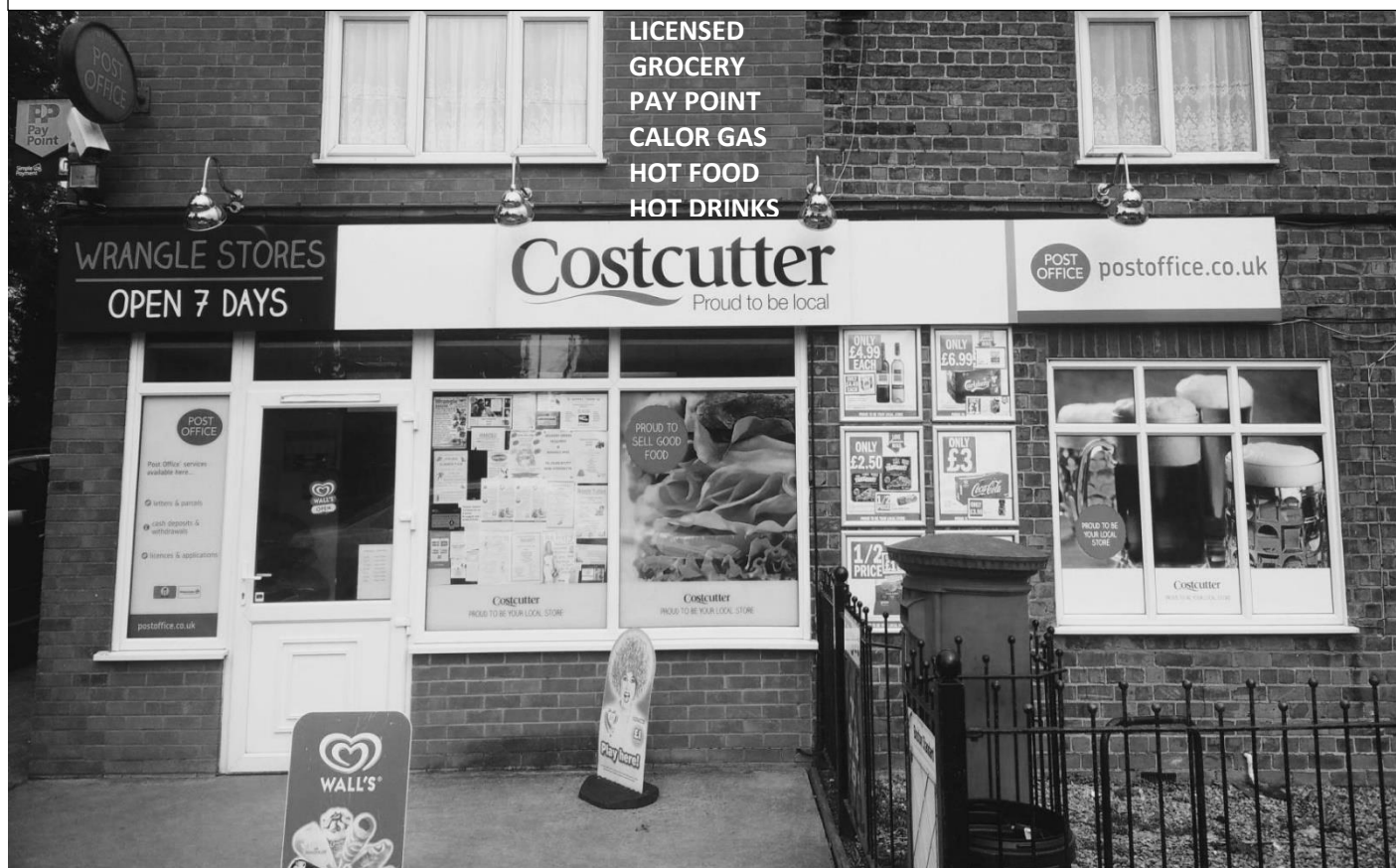
Update regarding the 4siting of a 5G mast in Wrangle
