Autumn brings a string of changes, mid-October and the last of the swallows have gone while the pinkfeet geese are already here, flying in from the Wash every morning to feed on the maize stubble. We hear them calling long before they appear, mostly in a series of 'V's' or skeins which become a gaggle when they break formation to drop down onto the fields.

The cattle, having spent the summer grazing the pastures, are now looking to come in to the yards where they can enjoy a more comfortable life, with shelter when needed, and plenty of good silage to eat. Most of our young stock are already in and the rest will soon follow.

We are currently lifting a heavy crop of red potatoes and hope for enough dry weather to complete the job. There's a real shortage of small birds and very few are coming to my feeders. We always had plenty of sparrows but none at all at present. Despite this I was delighted recently, when pulling up at Sibsey crossing, to see a flock of house sparrows busily picking grains of some sort from beside the kerb. I couldn't hear the train so watched through my binoculars as more and more sparrows joined the crowd. Suddenly they all flew across the road into some small trees, and the train passed through. There must have been at least fifty!

We have had issues with wilful damage at the Recreation Field. The culprits, young people who think it's clever to damage facilities put there for the enjoyment of others. If you see anything happening, and know who it is or where they come from, please inform the police on 101 or any member of the Parish Council (phone numbers at the back of this magazine). When the offenders get older and, hopefully have some common sense, they will regret their thoughtless actions.

Bonfire Guide

In order to avoid problems and possible legal action, it is recommended that you follow the checklist below.-

- Only burn dry material.
- Never burn household rubbish, rubber tyres, or anything containing plastic, foam or paint.
- Never use old engine oil, methylated spirits or petrol to light a bonfire or to 'encourage it'.
- Avoid lighting a fire in unsuitable weather conditions - smoke hangs in the air on damp, still days and in the evening.
- Avoid burning if the wind will take any smoke into neighbours gardens/houses and across roads.
- Avoid burning at weekends and on bank holidays when people want to enjoy their gardens.
- Never leave a fire unattended or leave it to smoulder.

Bonfires can be dangerous. Fire can spread to fences or buildings and scorch trees and plants.

Exploding bottles and cans are a hazard when rubbish is burned.

The Fire and Rescue Service will deal with bonfires if there is a risk to the safety of people or buildings.
