Here we go again, back in a Sheffield hospital and, I hope, for the last time. It is a long way to come but the care couldn't be better. Apparently my operation went very well. I am looking forward to getting back on the farm.

The cover picture shows one of the new gates, recently erected by the Environment Agency, to make it easier for walkers using the King Charles Coastal Path. You will notice that the short gate is easily opened by moving the long bar sideways. The gate readily swings out and up and then when released will fall back and click shut. Perfect, you may think, but the cattle, on approach will put their heads over the gate and quickly learn to open it. As the last one files through the gate will click shut behind. I wonder if they will all be charged for parking at Gibralter Point? I now need to ring the person responsible for this section of bank at the EA and explain my intention to lock the gates together. The original gates were left wide open 3 times last summer, causing us a lot of time and effort to get them back.

We trim several hedges annually, mainly roadside, but leave most to grow wild and produce a wealth of berries for the visiting winter thrushes. I was surprised at the end of January to see a few sprigs of hawthorn with small, young bright green leaves.

We are plashing again and have another 200 meters to finish at Days Orchard. A sign of spring approaching - we have several pairs of various ducks on our roadside wetland, MALLARDS, WIGEON, TEAL, SHOVELERS and GADWALL as well as Canada and Greylag geese, Curlews and Little Egrets. I was especially pleased to observe a pair of long tailed tit's, tiny birds except for their tails.



### Notes of the Wrangle Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 4th February 2025.

Two members of the public were present, they enquired about several items:

**Dog waste bins**, it was advised there had been two new bins purchased, one next to the bus shelter at the top of Tooley Lane on and one outside the Methodist Church on the A52.

Sale of the Methodist Church, no further information had been heard.

**Kimes Yard**, it was asked if there was anything happening here, Borough Cllr Butler advised they were redesigning the development and were looking to put through new plans in the future.

**The condition of the pavements**, especially the mud, the resident advised they had reported the mud on 'fix my street' with photos and read out the report.

**5g Mast developments**, the Clerk read out an email from Richard Tice's office, which is also covered as an Agenda Item.

Apologies: Apologies were accepted from Cllrs Hill and Pickett and Borough Cllr Baxter.

Present: Cllrs Ashton (Chairman), Dickason, Bowles, Edwards, Law, Seymour and Wrisdale.

Also present: County Cllr Skinner and Borough Cllr Butler.

### **Declarations of interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

### Approve minutes of the meeting held 03 December 2024

It was resolved that the minutes, previously circulated, be signed as the minutes.

### To receive reports from representatives on outside bodies:

### **Borough Cllr Butler Reported:**

Cllr Baxter continues to work with Cllr Skinner and LCC to see if the local buses could run through Church End again. Cllr Butler and Cllr Baxter attended the recent Plough Sunday on 26 January, it was great to see so many in attendance. Residents have contacted both Cllr Butler and Cllr Baxter regarding flooding and drains, smoke/pollution, damage to roads caused by Tractors and potholes. They both continue to report these issues on Fix My Street or feed back to the relevant department in the Borough Council to try and resolve them. Council Tax support for some of the most vulnerable residents has been increased to 100% this will provide a huge help. Boston Brilliance is due to be held on 14/15 February.

### **County Councillor Skinner reported:**

Flooding issues continue to be addressed. Anglian Water have made observations to a storm cover on Chapel Road, this is to be investigated. Highways are going to be clearing the drains out.

### <u>To receive an update on the siting of two bus shelters on the A52 in the area of Sea Lane</u> junction.

The Clerk had spoken with County Cllr Skinner who was looking into this. It was advised that everything was in order and that everything could go ahead.

The Clerk will speak with the resident close to where one of the bus shelters is due to be sited to make sure it won't cause any obstruction to their view when pulling out onto the A52.

### To receive update regarding Community Speed Sign

Cllr Dickason met with a representative from Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership. They discussed options for a new speed sign and relocating the current sign to a different location in the village. The Clerk is to clarify a few points, but it was moved seconded and agreed to go ahead with the purchase of a new sign and a new pole for the sign to be attached to.

### **Update regarding the 5G mast**

Richard Tice's office have said that there are currently no plans or applications to put a mast up in Wrangle. They are aware of the original site, which was stopped, but there are no plans to re-site it at this time. Richard is very keen to improve connectivity across the whole constituency and they are in close contact with the mobile networks and open reach.

### **Highways**

Cllr Bowles reported that the Stiles on the sea bank have been replaced with new gates.

**Description of works**: Street lighting column replacement scheme. **Reason for works**: Existing steel columns have been identified as a risk and need replacing. **Main contractor**: Lincolnshire County Council Highways. Balfour Beatty Group/E.ON Highways Lighting.

Commencement date: 09 April 2025 for up to 4 weeks.

### **Recreation Field**

Update on Tree/Hedge work: The work is due to be carried out in February, weather dependant. Update on the Tree survey: This has been carried out, results to be reviewed and reported back. Two quotations have been received to clean the play equipment, it was agreed which company would be asked to carry out the work once all tree/hedge work has been completed. The Goal Posts are broken and will be removed as soon as possible. It was reported that Moles are back on the field, it was agreed to keep an eye on the situation. The high-Water bill from Wave Water was discussed, the Clerk and Cllr Dickason checked the buildings and field for any leaks. After investigations the bill is believed to be correct. Meter readings will regularly be checked. The electricity has a fixed rate on both meters for 1 year with a reduced standing charge, this should result in a saving over the year.


