"One man went to mow." It must be a rare sight now because a local farmer-friend pulled up and snapped my picture from his vehicle. He said he never sees anyone mowing anymore. He went on to recall when, in his younger days, their farm staff had to mow all their dykes with scythes, and at piece work. It was the same on our farm, and that's where I learned to use one. I carry a scythe in the back of my truck, and use it frequently throughout the year. And what a year? Let's hope we'll soon be finished with all this rain. The land is well and truly soddened and the veg. rigs are doing enormous damage, both to the crops and to the soil structure. The problems now won't be the end of it either. Autumn drilling or ploughing for winter look like being another struggle unless, that is, there's a sudden dry-up, but time is getting on. Luckily we got the heavy, Brickyard land ploughed dry, just before the wet set in.

I watched a very large 'gaggle' of pinkfeet geese flying inland from the Wash this morning (10th Oct). These will be some of the first grey geese to arrive from Iceland, for their winter feeding grounds. I have used the word gaggle because that is the correct collective noun for a flock of geese, in no particular formation, that are honking continuously. It sounds right, doesn't it? When they are flying in their wide 'V' formation it is, of course, a skein. The small flocks of greylag and Canada geese we see throughout the year, and spend most of their time on our wetlands, are resident and breed here. The smaller, much darker brent geese that summer in Siberia began arriving to the Wash marshes a few weeks ago, but rarely come inland.

From the desk of your Vicar...

Simplistically stated: years ago when someone died they usually died at home or in the fields; the women of the village would deal with laying out the body and the friends and family of the loved one departed would take them, in a coffin made by the local carpenter, to the parish church where there would be a graveside service and burial. Death happened in the midst of life, everyone young and old knew that it happened and, of course, there were many more young deaths with higher infant mortality, and deaths from influenza small pox and so on – some illnesses taking whole families or decimating them. My point is that death was not hidden and secret but faced full on.

In contrast today death is hardly talked about, as though by speaking of it I invite it in! More and more often death is not at home but in a hospice or behind hospital curtains, we buy in professionals to take care of the body and again, often, the service to say goodbye is not in the middle of the village but in that curious place reserved for death – the crematorium. My point is that death is hidden away and even talk of it avoided!

One disastrous result of this social change is that we expect the bereaved to 'get over it' and folk don't know how to talk to people who have lost someone, so they cross the road...

As Christians we believe that Christ beat the last enemy – death – but we do not deny how hard it is to lose our loved ones. As churchgoers we know that loss lasts and lasts and that grief can rush back into the fullest of focus in alarming ways.

Each Autumn we provide a special service where we can particularly recall loved ones lost, where their names can be spoken, where we have space to be quiet and where no one will say – 'Aren't you over that?' This year our **Service of Thanksgiving and Memory at St Mary & St Nicholas, Wrangle is on Wednesday 30th October at 7pm.**

Please come along and join us if you feel it may be of help to you and please mention it to others who may find it of comfort.
