The month opens with election time again! Remember to use your vote and make good the sacrifices of so many who fought to get us, ordinary folk, the vote.

In voting find out what the candidates stand for and cast your vote for the common good. Seeking the common good means looking out for the welfare of all people, not just putting 'me' at the top of the list. It is looking for the long term good of the many not just the short-term gain of me and people like me. This Christian Aid Week, together, we can make childbirth safe for mums and babies. Through our gifts and prayers, we can help give the world's poorest mums a chance to live; together we have the power to transform lives. Our Christian Aid Week service this year will be at Wrangle Parish Church at 11.00am on Sunday 12th May, this will be a joint service with our friends from the Methodist Chapel; do join us. Together we can create a world where everyone can live a full life, free from poverty.
