Through our gifts and prayers, we can help give the world's poorest mums a chance to live; together we have the power to transform lives. Our Christian Aid Week service this year will be at Wrangle Parish Church at 11.00am on Sunday 12th May, this will be a joint service with our friends from the Methodist Chapel; do join us. Together we can create a world where everyone can live a full life, free from poverty.




