All that lovely, dry weather when we longed for rain, and now look at it! In the four days from Monday morning, 10th June, I measured 163mm (6.5 ins). Standing water on most fields, dykes brimming over and the prospect of hundreds of acres of veg. plants wilting and dying off. We can make all the plans we like but the weather really makes many of our decisions.

It has taken me several days of emails and phone calls to persuade the Environment Agency to grant permission for me to pump water, from the overflowing IDB drain, to top up our still very low brickpit. Believe it or not I still have to measure and pay for the water. It's not as if anyone else needed, or even wanted it! I'm pleased to say that the cattle withstood the deluge, and I am thankful that we have plenty of trees and hedges to afford them shelter.

Sunday 7th July is Wrangle Show day and promises to be another amazing day of displays and attractions, all put on for the village by a small committee and willing volunteers. Extra help is always welcomed, both in setting up and helping to run the show on the day. Do please come along and support the show. Let's make it another great success.

There are many young, fledgling birds about, often easily identified as they crouch, with slightly-opened, quivering wings pleading with their parents to give them food. Just think, only a few short weeks ago each one was a tiny egg, with a little yellow yolk, and now they are feathered and can fly around. Isn't nature wonderful?

From the desk of your Vicar...

Well summer should be well and truly here by the time this magazine hits your door mats! I hope that it is a lovely one with lots of glorious weather in which to enjoy the beautiful part of the country we have the pleasure to call home.

I have been looking at our weeds – they are so resilient! They even grow through the tarmac of the driveway, they are strong – this seems especially true of old established weeds. New weeds, it appears, are much more easily dealt with. So, I asked advice of a wise old hand on how to deal with a deeply rooted weed that continually reoccurs – well if I was after a quick fix, it did not come. The advice was to keep the ground well dug all year, year after year and to make sure the ground was well manured as well as to constantly remove any of the weed that you find.

Suddenly this seemed like wonderful advice to improve my life; keep digging at life and removing what is bad or selfish and damaging, not because it will not happen again but because, by tackling it now, and being ready to tackle it again - if it reoccurs, it will gradually weaken and have less of a hold on us and by degrees become less rampant. Then to ensure the soil is fed properly must equate with good food for the soul – doing and reading the things that inspire and nourish our inner self and being more fully ourselves, not starving through inattention or busyness the self we are at our core. So, if by attention and persistence we can be rid of weeds let us use the same strategy to improve ourselves!

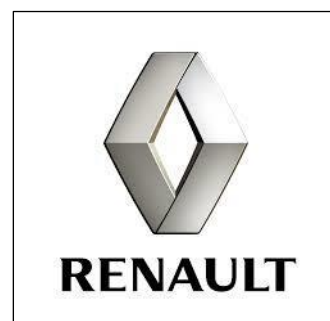
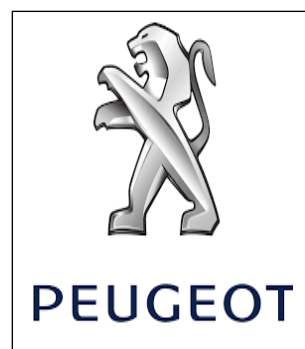

Also present: Five members of the public were present. Four came along to report issues with the Main Road, in the area of the school, causing vibrations through their properties. County Cllr Skinner will deal with this matter. They left the meeting. One resident came along to listen to the meeting.

Declarations of interest

There were no declarations of interest.

Approve Minutes of the Annual Parish Council meeting and the last ordinary meeting

Notes of the Annual Parish Council meeting held on 07 May 2019 were read out by the Clerk, approved and signed. Notes of the ordinary meeting held on Tuesday 07 May 2019, previously circulated, were approved and signed as the minutes.

To receive reports from representatives on outside bodies

The PCSO reported by email, incidents to 07 May:

1 suspicious circumstance at Main Road; **2** traffic offences at Main Road and at Mel Marshall Way; **1** transport hazard at Park Lane; **2** road traffic collisions at Main Road and **1** burglary at Greengate

Borough Councillor Pickett reported that there has been a number of inductions to attend.

The County Councillor reported:

He is Chairman of LCC Flood and Water Committee and he has been attending training events.

Cllrs Seymour and Bowles reported from the South East Lincolnshire Local Plan training:

It was interesting, but more detail could be in the final plan. Wrangle has: 1 area of allocated housing, 1 area committed for housing and 1 conservation area. Archaeological digs are no longer required on a development site. S106 agreements apply to developments with more than nine properties. The Borough Council needs to have a five year supply of housing.

Highways

The only highways issue was discussed in the Public Forum.

Recreation Field

The Borough Council have now advised that Building Notice is not required for this project. The paperwork will be completed and sent to the Grant funders. A meeting was held with Anglian Water who will put a detailed plan together of their proposal ready for the July meeting.

The plastic glass in both doors of the notice board has been smashed.

There is a problem with dog faeces in the recreation field. Please, if you walk your dog in the field CLEAN UP AFTER IT! You are not the only user of the field. Information about the Public Open Spaces Protection Order for Boston Borough Council is in the notice boards at the Recreation Field and the Parish Hall. ***The Order applies to all land within the administrative are of the Borough of Boston to which the public have access.***
