From the desk of your Vicar...

The feast of Pentecost falls on the 9th June this year, so I look forward to seeing you at our service in celebration of the church's 'birthday', here in Wrangle it is at 11.00am and it is Morning Prayer.

I am pleased to let you know that we are going to have a fairly local Confirmation Service on the 1st December. It is to be held at Holy Trinity, Boston at 4.00pm and Bishop Nicholas with be the one doing the confirmations.

Many of us (myself included!) were baptised as children – 'confirmation' is a taking for yourself those promises that were made by parents and god-parents on your behalf. But not being baptised is not a problem as baptism can be offered at the confirmation service or during our preparation for it. It is about becoming a full member of the Church.

I am hoping to prepare both young people and adults for this service. Young people need to be in year five or above at school ... there is no upper age limit. Confirmation preparation allows us the opportunity to really explore the basics of our faith and work out our own understanding of God; we explore God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, Church, Creeds, the bible, Christian living, Prayer and worship, including Holy Communion and so on. The idea is that participants have the space to decide if they would like to be confirmed within the Church of England, if so they go forward for confirmation.

The preparation takes place in six classes, each about an hour and a half, and, as we have plenty of time, and to make it nice and easy, I'm planning these classes to be two weeks apart. The day, times, dates, location etc. to be agreed with those who decide to take this step.







ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

The Annual Parish Meeting was held on Tuesday 07 May 2019 in the Parish Hall. Where, after the minutes of the meeting held on 01 May 2018 were approved and signed, the Chairman of the Parish Council gave the following Annual Report to Parishioners:

"Despite all the doom and gloom felt over our national politics, life in Wrangle carries on pretty much as normal.

The sea banks improvement works continued throughout the summer and much of the job was completed in decent weather. The contractors are to return to tidy up this summer. Public access to the banks and marsh is currently restricted, and we are striving to get this put right.

It is generally felt that, in Wrangle, we do things well. This was born out again with a very successful annual show, and an excellent flower festival at the Church. Well done to all involved.

Having decided to have the Parish News professionally printed the photo copier, which was nearing the end of its life, was disposed of. Our magazine is very popular and we must thank Teddy and Pearl for setting out and editing, and also all those who help with distribution.

Our meetings have been fairly well attended, with emailed police reports usually available. The interactive speed sign yields a constant percentage of compliant drivers, but there is always a significant number speeding, including one vehicle passing through our village at 100 miles per hour.

We have again helped village organisations with \$137 donations.

Outline planning approval has been granted for two large developments, of 45 dwellings at each site but, since so many other villages have received similar approvals, it remains to be seen if there will be sufficient developers to bring these to fruition.

The Community Orchard is looking well, the trees having been mulched and fertilised but more significant rain is needed for them to benefit. The Centenary Spinney has been tidied up with the help of a Countryside Agency Grant, but the contractors carefully avoided clearing the blackthorn. Volunteers have done some of this work.

The newly formed Wrangle History Group was given a donation to enable it to acquire suitable storage equipment for the information gathered. Two sessions of first aid training have taken place recently, led by the British Red Cross, these were well attended.

The Parish Council has been awarded a grant from The Coastal Community Fund to help finance the refurbishment of the toilet block at the Recreation Field. The Show Committee plans to provide a Wrangle Village sign, and has asked the Parish Council for advice and possible part funding.

The green area at Mel Marshall Way has, finally, been registered to the Parish Council and a sum commuted to fund maintenance for 15 years. Sadly, fly-tipping is on the increase and much heavier fines are needed to deter offenders.

Finally, my thanks to all our members for your support and attendance during the year, especially to my vice chairman and to our clerk, Teddy, who has done an excellent job in keeping abreast of all the legislation changes, and work with the magazine and website.

Having just had an election, we now find we are one member short. It is many thanks and goodbye to Bryan Ingham and Stephanie Dickens, who have stood down, and a warm welcome to Stephen Seymour, a regular attendee at our meetings.

I wish you all well for the ensuing year."

The accounts for the Wrangle consolidated Charities and the Alenson & Erskine Foundation were outlined, there were no issues raised. There being no correspondence, or members of the public present the meeting closed and was followed by the:

Highways


