From the desk of your Vicar...

Bells are some of the oldest musical instruments in the world and are said to date back to China in around 3500 BC. Bells are certainly the loudest musical instruments and can be heard from many miles away over land or sea.

To many, the sound of ringing church bells is quintessentially English. We also have Big Ben, The Lutine Bell, school bells and ship's bells. We have bells in our nursery rhymes – "Oranges and Lemons say the Bells of St Clements"; we have bells in our language expressions: "Go like the Clappers", "Ring the Changes" as well as having "Peals of laughter".

We also have bells throughout English history – from the Anglo-Saxon curfew bell, introduced by Alfred the Great, to Churchill's Second World War Decree that all church bells should be silenced so that their ringing could be reserved to warn of enemy invasion.

Bells were first authorised for use in Christian churches in around 400 AD and by about 600 AD they had become common in the monasteries of Europe, Bede reports on them in England at around that time.

So, for well over a thousand years Church bells have been rung to call the faithful to worship, signalling the start of a service of worship, they have also been rung at various points during the service so that those unable to attend would know exactly what part the service had been reached.

In Britain, and predominantly in the Church of England, originating in the early 17th century, there is a strong tradition of bell ringing for about half an hour before a service.

In Wrangle Parish Church we have a peal of six bells, these are rung for special services and, if requested, for weddings. But it is very unusual now for the bell to be tolled for funerals. A single bell is used as our call to Sunday worship.

Our Bell Ringers practice on a Thursday evening – newcomers are always welcome!

The use of bells is a wonderful connection to the enormous history they represent so, when our bells do ring out do enjoy them!

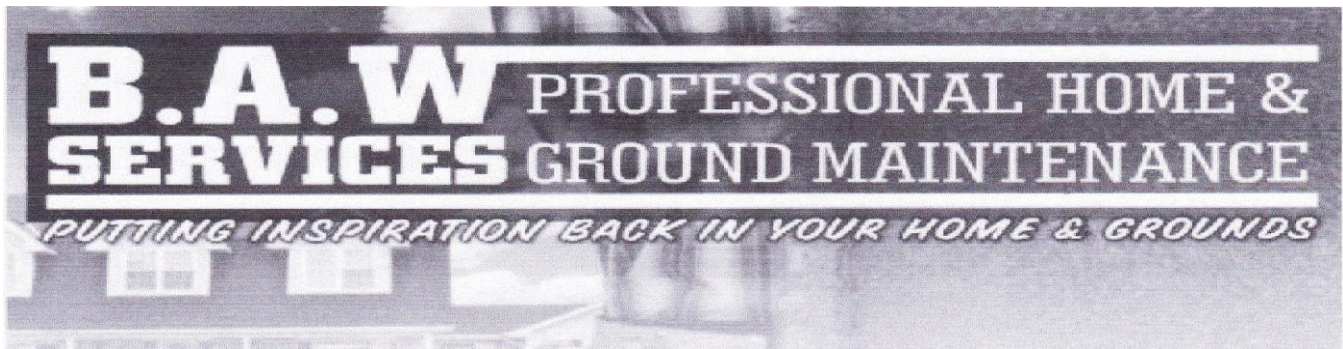

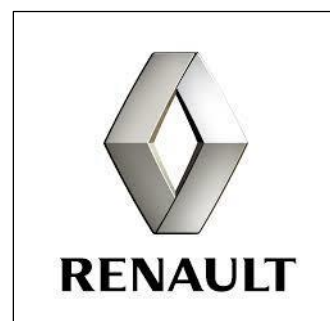
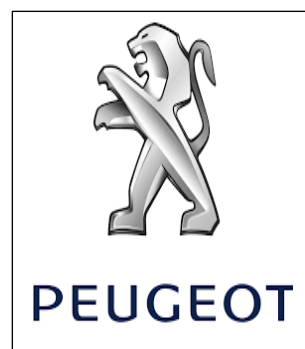
