It's Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March and I'm sitting in my pickup on the outer sea bank. It is sunny with a strong S.W. wind again and, thankfully, helping to dry things up a bit though more rain is forecast this week.

The footpath on this bank is now open for public use and is mostly level and a good walk. The stile steps have been removed and the route through the boundary fences is now by the 12 foot steel gates. Highways have been and put 'Please Close the Gate' signs on all of these and I hope people will do that, otherwise the cattle will stray or become mixed up with someone else's.

On the 1810 bank, near the Sailors' Home, the stile has been replaced with a new kissing gate which, sadly, is bright galvanised steel (see cover picture). I feel this would have been better in wood as it would have blended in more. They have also erected some new footpath directional signs.

Looking out to sea there is just one fishing smack and it appears to be trawling, I expect for shrimps. This is a beautiful vista, across to the Norfolk coast and, as ever, is wonderfully peaceful. I am always amazed how few people come down to enjoy it.

#### From the desk of your Vicar...

He is Risen! He is Risen, indeed, Alleluia! I wish you all a blessed time this Easter. Easter is perhaps the most important of our Church Festivals, more important than the other greats of Christmas and Pentecost. The Easter story moves from the triumph of Palm Sunday, with the crowds acclaim of Jesus, through his teaching in the temple courts, as the crowds increase for the great Jewish feast of Passover, towards the last evening with his disciples and the beginning of the Lords Supper at Jesus's own hands. Then there is the drama of an arrest, the mockery of a trial and the brutal execution of Jesus. Powerful stuff – and then the pause of utter devastation as the disciples are stunned by what they have just been part of and by their need to keep the Sabbath. They are face to face with their worst nightmare – death. Not just the horrendous death of their friend and teacher, but also the death of hopes and dreams. It is easy for us to race over that bit because we have heard the story before – but those first followers had to live it, moment by moment. But then we do have Easter Sunday – remembered Sunday by Sunday as little Easters – the day of confusion, of an empty tomb, of seeing Jesus again; of dawning realisation that Jesus had triumphed over death, that the story did not end in misery on the cross but was still well and truly alive ...

The Easter story central to our faith; what difference does it make to your life?

Join us in your local church at our celebrations this Easter time: Palm Sunday (5<sup>th</sup>) – 11.00; Tuesday (7<sup>th</sup>) of Holy Week 7pm Compline; Easter Day (12th) Parish Communion at 11.00.

#### **Coronavirus (COVID-19)**

The Church of England is keeping parish priests and other church leaders informed every day about the precautions that it is felt wise to put in place at this time of risk of infection from the corona virus.

So at the time of writing we are taking Holy Communion in one kind only – that is having the bread but not sharing wine in a common cup.

I use a hand sanitizer before I prepare the Holy Communion. We stand to take Holy Communion to avoid many hands touching the communion rail.

We have stopped shaking hands or hugging one another when we share the peace, but are experimenting with other ways of sharing the peace, without contact, using British Sign Language is one choice, there are others. We have also stopped contact at individual blessing.

We have stopped passing the collection plate hand to hand.

In line with general advice those who are unwell with coughs and colds, etc. are asked to stay home.

As advice is updated daily no doubt there will be other changes.

We wish to protect the vulnerable in our congregations and parishes.

My hope and prayer is that you all keep well.
