From the desk of your Vicar...

Isn't it wonderful to witness the signs of Spring – lighter mornings and evenings, even the sight of daffodils. Hopefully we'll soon be warm in Spring sunshine, meanwhile do keep an eye out for your neighbours in the remaining cold snaps.

Easter is 12 April this year, so look out for our Holy Week and Easter Services in the next magazine. Lent, the season of preparation for Easter, began on Wednesday 26 February, so the whole of March falls into Lent this year.....

Lent is traditionally associated with 'giving something up' but it is so much more than that, it's about examining ourselves and looking very honestly at who we are and how we are living, treating others and so on. Then we consider who we really wish to be, how we want ideally to live to treat those around us – perhaps even how we would like to be remembered. Then we take a step towards who we would like to be – perhaps only a small step, eating more healthily for example.

Lent is about this self-examination and getting our life back onto its correct path, it has long been associated, too, with acts of generosity to those who have fallen on hard times or who simply do not have what we have, but this erupts out of the same act of honestly looking at ourselves. So I encourage you to keep a Holy Lent, to seek to change yourself for the better and to be generous to those in difficulty.

Our Lent Course is to take place on Thursday afternoons – we begin on Thursday 05 March. The course will be based on the book "Talking of God Together" – there will be loads of room for comment and discussion. The course will run from 2.00pm to 3.30pm on the Thursdays 05, 12, and 26 March and 02 April. We shall meet at the Methodist Chapel on the Main Road in Wrangle; I shall be leading some of the sessions as will Reverend Julie Doddrell. It promises to be an interesting study so please join us – and I'm sure we'll have refreshments too!

Lead theft in our diocese

The past 12 months have been a particularly difficult year for many of our parishes due to a significant rise in lead thefts. In total, 30 churches have been targeted, and despite the arrest of four suspects in December 2019 the problem has not abated – within the first two weeks of the new year two further thefts had taken place.

Lead theft is a devastating crime not only for the parish, but also for the wider community. The cost involved for the replacement of the lead using terne-coated stainless steel – a far less attractive material for metal thieves – can be considerable. Most insurers will cover the cost of a replacement roof if the church is alarmed, has SmartWater and all of the appropriate signage. Where a church doesn't have an alarm, but has the other precautions it is likely the pay-out will be capped at around £7500. With the latter the net result is that parishes have to find the repair and reinstatement costs from a combination of church funds and charitable grant givers.

On average the replacement of an aisle roof can cost in the region of £30,000, and a nave roof, with more scaffolding involved, can be as much as £70–80,000. Therefore, it is in everybody's interests to try and minimise the risk of lead theft from a church. With this in mind, and if there is lead at your church, here is some advice:

- ➤ Make sure that where you already have Smart Water or similar it is up to date, registered and the appropriate signage has been installed.
- > If you have an alarm ensure it is checked regularly and serviced as required.
- ➤ Be on the alert for suspicious activity around the church and ask parishioners who live close to the church to be especially vigilant. Any suspicious activity can be reported using the police 101 number, and if you think a crime is in progress then ring 999.

Further advice about lead theft can be found on the diocesan website, where there is also advice on what to do if the worst happens and who to contact in the diocesan Church Buildings department if it does.

THE RECYCLING CENTRE AT THE RECREATION FIELD

This photo was recently taken of rubbish dumped by the recycling bins in the recreation field.

The cardboard could have been put in the newspaper bin.

The bucket and televisions should be taken to the recycling centre where there is a specific place for them to be placed for recycling.

If you cannot get to the recycling centre then Boston Borough Council will arrange to collect them from you, at a cost. If you get someone else to take them to the tip for you, always make sure they have a tipping licence – if the rubbish is dumped and traced back to the owner then the owner will be fined, if you have the licence number then the owner of the licence will be fined for fly tipping.

FROM THE BOROUGH COUNCIL WEBSITE:

We operate a pre-paid collection and disposal service for large household items which householders may find difficult to transport to the Household Waste Recycling Centre.

Prices below are only a guideline and subject to amendment depending on the size and weight of certain objects. Electric/reclining chairs or beds for example will be a lot more expensive than a standard priced items, as these are heavy objects.

Standard items:

1 to 2 items = £18 3 items = £25 4 to 5 items = £30

Large white electrical items such as fridge-freezers or chest freezers:

1 large white item = £26.25 2 large white items = £36.75

If you have more than 5 items, please call 01205 314200 to discuss this with an Advisor.

Please note the Borough Council **CANNOT** collect building materials, asbestos, hazardous waste or medical waste.

<u>Please use the recycling facility responsibly</u>. If you see anyone fly tipping in this area please report it to the Borough Council who can take any necessary action.

It's fair to say 2019 was a challenging year for the Board. We had two significant rainfall events in June and October/November. From January to November 2019 we took 786mm of rain (31 inches) across the District, compared to around 570mm (22 inches) in a "normal" year. During the River Steeping Breach in June 2019, the Board worked with the Environment Agency, and other bodies, to take 1 million tonnes of water from the River Steeping into our system (see picture) to avoid more flooding in Wainfleet. The cost of pumping this extra water was paid for by Government.

From January to November 2019 we pumped a total of 17,710 hours in our manned and unmanned pumping stations compared to a "normal" year of just 12,000 hours.

One of the unfortunate affects of heavy rainfall and saturated ground is drain bank slips. We have had nearly 40 slips across the District since last June totalling over 240 metres in length. We understand how frustrating it is for local residents when slip repairs are taking place and roads need to be closed, but I am pleased that the large slip on the Fodderdyke Drain Bank should be completed by Friday 24 January 2020.

Finally, the **Heritage Open Day** at Lade bank will take place on **19 September 2020**, from 10.00am until 4.00pm and, water levels permitting, we will run one of the Ruston & Hornsby diesel pumps at 1.00pm. This year, we are planning to unveil a completely new display for the visitors to see.




