Not having produced a magazine for two months, I feel I should report on the position regarding the church roof. The theft of lead, back in October, followed by the wettest 'back end' and winter we have known, along with the numerous gales has caused a lot of work for our volunteers. First securing waterproof sheeting, and re-securing after strong winds, moving things to drier areas and covering pews were just a start. Numerous buckets, bins and anything that would hold water were strategically sited and, of course, had to be emptied frequently.

Our quinquennial survey stated that a better, temporary covering was urgently needed to look after the timbers etc. and other church fixtures. When the rain finally stopped the ensuing drought provided contractors with the opportunity to install a really good, guaranteed cover.

Next the clearing up began, and what a wonderful job our volunteers have done. Our sincere thanks to everyone, who has worked so hard to bring our lovely church back into such a good, sparkling state.

For the future we have to look at an even more expensive, permanent cover. Fund raising has already begun. Thank you to Wrangle Stores for allowing us to have a collecting tin on the counter. We have received some donations and there is a facility for anyone to donate directly into the roof fund, as explained in the magazine. We look forward to resuming coffee mornings etc. as soon as possible.

As well as the church, the churchyard is a joy to behold and many thanks to all those who have made this happen. We await permission to hold our services again.

Do look after yourselves, stay safe and well.

In August 2008, so almost twelve years ago my husband and I moved into the Old Leake Vicarage as I became Priest of Old Leake with Wrangle and Friskney from that September. It is now time for me to move on.

Thank you for the warm welcome you showed me when I came and for the great privilege I have enjoyed of walking with so many of you through some of life's milestone moments... I have been honoured to be with families in times of terrible loss, I have shared the love, joy, hope and potential as couples join their lives in holy matrimony and I have held precious young lives as they are brought to God in thanksgiving to start their Christian journey in Baptism. Thank you too for your support at some of our important services – Remembrance, Plough Sunday and Christmas, for example, and thanks to those faithful regular attenders at Church who help me to keep our community enfolded in prayer and held before God.

It became obvious to me last autumn that the job had grown to a point that I could no longer sustain the ministry needed in the way I wished to fulfil it. Over the years elements of the job have got larger – the identity checks and preliminaries to wedding, the volume of reading as a school governor, data protection, safeguarding and permissions to do necessary works on grade 1 listed buildings, to name but a few. In twelve years I have not got any younger!

I prayerfully considered the future and I have applied for and been appointed to a part time role in Leicester Diocese. So I concluded my role here on the 30th June 2020.

I had no idea, of course, that my leaving would coincide with such “strange times” and it now seems unlikely that any formal church worship will happen before I step aside.

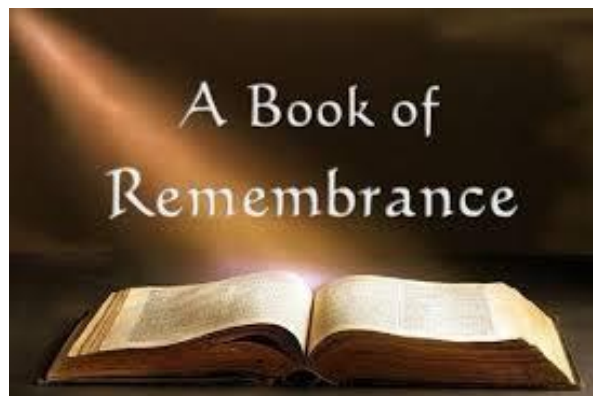


BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

Contact tracers will never:

- Ask you to dial a premium rate number to speak to us (for example, those starting 09 or 087)
- Ask you to make any form of payment
- Ask for any details about your bank account
- Ask for your social media identities or login details, or those of your contacts
- Ask you for any passwords or PINs, or ask you to set up any passwords or PINs over the phone
- Ask you to purchase a product
- Ask you to download any software to your device or ask you to hand over control of your PC, smartphone or tablet
- Ask you to access any website that does not belong to the Government or NHS
